**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

*\*Fun Fur (Article #320). 100% Polyester; package size:*

**Solids:** 1.75 oz/50g; 64 yd/58m balls

**Prints:** 1.5 oz/40g; 57 yd/52m balls

**Exotics:** 1.75 oz/50g; 55 yd/50m balls (**Note:** Exotics shades are lay flat to dry)

#### MATERIALS

- 320-304 Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Night Sky Stripes  
10 Balls (A)
- 220-258 Lion Brand Fancy Fur Yarn: Night & Day  
3 Balls (B)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 19 [15 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Fancy Fur (Article #220). 55% Polyamide 45% Polyester ;*

*package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (39yds/35m) pull skeins*



#### GAUGE:

6.5 stitches + 12 rows = 4 in. [10 cm] in Garter stitch (knit every row) with 3 strands of A and 1 strand of B held together. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### RUG

**With 3 strands of A and 1 strand of B held together, cast on 28 stitches. Work in Garter stitch (knit every row) until piece measures 25 in. [63.5 cm] from beginning. Bind off.**

#### FINISHING

**Weave in ends.**
