SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: 6 mos, 12 mos

Sweater

Finished Chest 20³/₄ (25 ¹/₄) in. [52.5 (64) cm]

Finished Length 9³/₄ (11 ¹/₄) in. [25 (28.5) cm]

Hat 16 in. [40.5 cm] circumference

Mittens 5 in. [12.5 cm] circumference, 4¹/₄ in. [11 cm] long

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Dec 30, 2012)

SLEEVES

Inc Row (RS) ~~k-12-(16)~~ **k 1, M1, k 11 (15)**, p 2, 2/2 LC or 2/2 RC, p 2, ~~k-12-(16)~~, **k 11 (15)**, M1, k 1.

HAT

With ~~larger~~ **smaller** needles, cast on 98 sts loosely. Work 12 rows in K1, P1 Rib. Change to ~~smaller~~ **larger** needles.

MATERIALS

- 910-103 Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: Coral
3 (4) Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 3 [3.25 mm]
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 4 [3.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size E-4 (3.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Cable Needles (Set of 2)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
6 buttons 5/8 in. [16 mm] diameter

GAUGE:

24 sts + 32 rows = 4 in. [10 cm] in St st (k on RS, p on WS) on smaller needles.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

2/2 LC (2 over 2 left cross) Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k 2, then k 2 from cable needle.

2/2 RC (2 over 2 right cross) Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k 2, k 2 from cable

needle.

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and k them tog.

SWEATER

BACK

With smaller needles, cast on 62 (74) sts. Work 6 rows in K1, P1 Rib. Change to larger needles.

Row 1 (RS): K 12 (16), p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2, k 22 (26), p 2, 2/2 RC, p 2, k 12 (16).

Row 2: P 12 (16), k 2, p 4, k 2, p 22 (26), k 2, p 4, k 2, p 12 (16).

Row 3: K 12 (16), p 2, k 4, p 2, k 22 (26), p 2, k 4, p 2, k 12 (16).

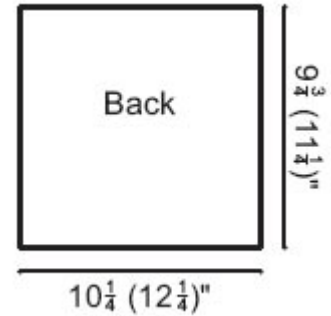
Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

Row 6: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-6 for 11 (13) more times.

Bind off in pattern as for Row 1, including cables.



LEFT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on 32 (38) sts. Work 6 rows in K1, P1 Rib. Change to larger needles.

Row 1 (RS): K 12 (16), p 2, 2/2 RC, p 2, k 12 (14).

Row 2: P 12 (14), k 2, p 4, k 2, p 12 (16).

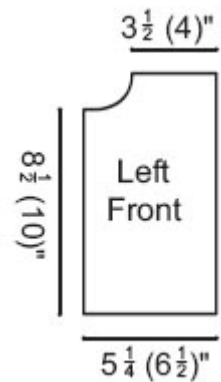
Row 3: K 12 (16), p 2, k 4, p 2, k 12 (14).

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

Row 6: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-6 for 9 (11) more times, then work Row 1 once.



Shape Neck

Next Row (WS): Bind off 6 (8) sts, work in pattern across row- 26 (30) sts.

Next Row (RS): Work even in pattern.

Next Row: Bind off 3 sts, work in pattern across row- 23 (27) sts.

Next Row: Work even in pattern.

Next Row: P2tog, work in pattern across row- 22 (26) sts.

Next Row: K 12 (16), p 2, 2/2 RC, p 2, k 2.

Next Row: P2tog, work across in pattern row- 21 (25) sts.

Work 4 rows even in pattern.

Bind off in pattern as for Row 1, including cable (2/2 RC).

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front until 1 row before Neck Shaping (do not work final Row 1), substituting 2/2 LC for 2/2 RC.

Shape Neck

Next Row (RS): Bind off 6 (8) sts, work in pattern across row - 26 (30) sts.

Next Row (WS): Work even in pattern.

Next Row: Bind off 3 sts, work in pattern across row - 23 (27) sts.

Next Row: Work even in pattern.

Next Row: K2tog, work in pattern across row - 22 (26) sts.

Next Row: Work even in pattern.

Next Row: K2tog, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2, k 12 (16) - 21 (25) sts.

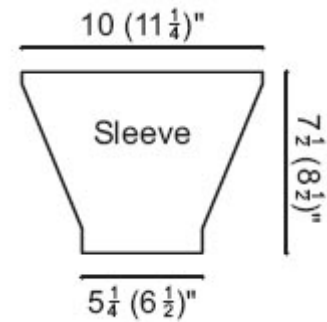
Work 5 rows even in pattern. Bind off in pattern as for Row 1, including cable (2/2 LC).

SLEEVES

Note

Make 1 Sleeve with 2/2 LC cable, and other with 2/2 RC cable. With smaller needles, cast on 32 (40) sts. Work 6 rows in K1, P1 Rib. Change to larger needles and begin pattern as follows:

Inc Row (RS): K 1, M1, k 11 (15), p 2, 2/2 LC or 2/2 RC, p 2, k 11 (15), M1, k 1. Work in 6-row pattern as established and, AT THE SAME TIME, inc 1 st each end every 4th row 14 more times, working inc sts in St st - 60 (68) sts. Work even until Sleeve measures 7 ½ (8 ½) in. [19 (21.5) cm] from beg, end with Row 6. Bind off in pattern as for Row 1, including cable (2/2 LC or 2/2 RC).



FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in Sleeves.

Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Collar

With smaller needles and from WS, pick up 61 (71) sts evenly spaced around neck edge.

Row 1: K 1, (p 1, k 1) across.

Rep Row 1 for Seed st 14 more times.

Bind off in pattern.

Button Band

With smaller needles and from RS, pick up 49 (59) sts along Right Front edge. Work in Seed st for 6 rows. Bind off in pattern.

Buttonhole Band

With smaller needles and from RS, pick up 49 (59) sts along Left Front edge. Work in Seed st for 3 rows.

Row 4 (Buttonhole Row): K 1, p 1, *k2tog, yo twice, p2tog, [k 1, p 1] 2 (3) times, rep from * 4 more times, k2tog, yo twice, p2tog, k 1, p 1, k 1. Continue in Seed st for 2 more rows. Bind off in pattern.

Sew buttons to Right Front button band opposite buttonholes. Weave in ends.

HAT

With smaller needles, cast on 98 sts loosely. Work 12 rows in K1, P1 Rib.

Change to larger needles. .

Row 1 (RS): K 13, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2, (k 24, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2) twice, k 13.

Row 2: P 13, k 2, p 4, k 2, (p 24, k 2, p 4, k 2) twice, p 13.

Row 3: K 13, p 2, k 4, p 2, (k 24, p 2, k 4, p 2) twice, k 13.

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

Row 6: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-6 twice more.

Row 19 (Dec Row): K 1, (k2tog, k 8, ssk, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2, k2tog, k 8, ssk) 3 times, k 1 - 86 sts.

Row 20: P 11, (k 2, p 4, k 2, p 20) twice, k 2, p 4, k 2, p 11.

Row 21: K 11, (p 2, k 4, p 2, k 20) twice, p 2, k 4, p 2, k 11.

Row 22: Rep Row 20.

Row 23 (Dec Row): K 1, (k2tog, k 6, ssk, p 2, k 4, p 2, k2tog, k 6, ssk) 3 times, k 1 - 74 sts.

Row 24: P 9, k 2, p 4, k 2, (p 16, k 2, p 4, k 2) twice, p 9.

Row 25: K 9, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2, (k 16, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2) twice, k 9.

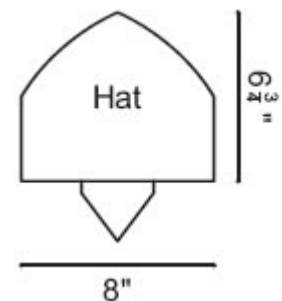
Row 26: Rep Row 24.

Row 27 (Dec Row): K 1, (k2tog, k 4, ssk, p 2, k 4, p 2, k2tog, k 4, ssk) 3 times, k 1 - 62 sts.

Row 28: P 7, k 2, p 4, k 2, (p 12, k 2, p 4, k 2) twice, p 7.

Row 29: K 7, p 2, k 4, p 2, (k 12, p 2, k 4, p 2) twice, k 7.

Row 30: Rep Row 28.



Row 31 (Dec Row): K 1, (k2tog, k 2, ssk, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2, k2tog, k 2, ssk) 3 times, k 1 - 50 sts.
Row 32: P 5, k 2, p 4, k 2, (p 8, k 2, p 4, k 2) twice, p 5.
Row 33: K 5, p 2, k 4, p 2, (k 8, p 2, k 4, p 2) twice, k 5.
Row 34: Rep Row 32.
Row 35 (Dec Row): K 1, (k2tog, ssk, p 2, k 4, p 2, k2tog, ssk) 3 times, k 1 - 38 sts.
Row 36: P 3, (k 2, p 4) 5 times, k 2, p 3.
Row 37 (Dec Row): K 1, ssk, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2, (k2tog, ssk, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2) twice, k2tog, k 1 - 32 sts.
Row 38: P 2, (k 2, p 4, k 2, p 2) 3 times.
Row 39: K 1, (k2tog across to last stitch), k 1 - 17 sts.
Row 40: Purl.
Row 41: K 1, (k2tog across row) - 9 sts.
Row 42: Purl.

FINISHING

Thread yarn through remaining sts twice and draw tight. Sew side seam. Make pompom and attach to top of Hat.

Ear Flaps

With smaller needles, pick up 15 sts along edge of Hat.

Rows 1-5: K 1, (p 1, k 1) across row
Row 6: P2tog, (k 1, p 1) to last 3 sts, k 1, p2tog - 13 sts.
Row 7: P 1, (k 1, p 1) across row.
Row 8: K2tog, (p 1, k 1) to last 3 sts, p 1, k2tog - 11 sts.
Row 9: K 1, (p 1, k 1) across row.
Row 10: Rep Row 6 - 9 sts.
Row 11: Rep Row 7.
Row 12: Rep Row 8 - 7 sts.
Row 13: Rep Row 9.
Row 14: Rep Row 6 - 5 sts.
Row 15: Rep Row 7.
Row 16: K2tog, p 1, k2tog - 3 sts.
Row 17: K 1, p 1, k 1.
 Rep Row 17 for 60 rows. Bind off. Make second Flap on opposite side of Hat. Weave in ends.

FIRST MITTEN

With smaller needles, cast on 32 sts. Work Rows 1-12 in K1, P1 Rib. Change to larger needles.

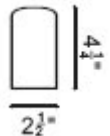
Row 13: K 4, p 2, 2/2 LC, p 2, k 20.
Row 14: P 20, (k 2, p 4) twice.
Row 15: (K 4, p 2) twice, k 20.
Row 16: Rep Row 14.
Row 17: Rep Row 15.
Row 18: Rep Row 14.
Rows 19-30: Rep Rows 13-18 twice more.
Row 31: Rep Row 13.
Row 32: P2tog 10 times, k2tog, p2tog twice, k2tog, p2tog twice - 16 sts.
Row 33: Knit.
Row 34: P2tog 8 times - 8 sts.

Thread yarn through remaining stitches twice and pull tight.

SECOND MITTEN

Work as for First Mitten through Row 12.

Row 13: K 20, p 2, 2/2 RC, p 2, k 4.
Row 14: (P 4, k 2) twice, p 20.
Row 15: K 20, (p 2, k 4) twice.
Row 16: Rep Row 14.
Row 17: Rep Row 15.
Row 18: Rep Row 14.
Rows 19-30: Rep Rows 13-18 twice more.
Row 31: Rep Row 13.



Row 32: P2tog twice, k2tog, p2tog twice, k2tog, p2tog 10 times - 16 sts.

Row 33: Knit.

Row 34: P2tog 8 times - 8 sts. Thread yarn through remaining stitches twice and pull tight.

FINISHING

Sew side seams. With crochet hook, chain 280 sts or until chain measures 28 in. [72 cm]. Fasten off. Sew one end of chain to each Mitten side seam. Weave in ends.
