SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference 12 in. [30.5 cm], unstretched

Finished Length 6 in. [15 cm]

CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

- 570-153 Lion Brand Festive Fur-Black
2 Skeins (A)
- 910-153 Lion Brand Microspun: Ebony
1 Skeins (B)
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials

1. Circular needle size 7 [4.5 mm], 16 in. [40.5 cm]
2. Circular needle size 9 [5.5 mm], 16 in. [40.5 cm]

GAUGE:

24 sts + 28 rnds = 4 in. [10 cm] in k 1, p 1 rib with B on smaller needle. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

HAT

With smaller needle and B cast on 72 sts. Place marker for beg of rnd and join, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: *K 1, p 1, rep from * around.

Rep Rnd 1 for k 1, p 1 rib until piece measures 5½ in. [14 cm] from beg.

Next Rnd (Inc Rnd): *K 2, inc 1 in next st, rep from * around – 96 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds once – 128 stitches. Join A and change to larger needles.

Next Rnd (Inc Rnd): With 1 strand of A and 1 strand of B held tog, *K 7, inc 1, rep from * around – 144 sts.

Work 6 rnds even, then work dec rnds as follows:

Next Rnd: (K 1, k2tog) around – 96 sts.

Next Rnd: Work even.

Rep last 2 rounds once – 64 sts.

Next Rnd: K2tog around – 32 sts.

Next Rnd: Work even.

Next Rnd: K2tog around – 16 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tail into large-eyed blunt needle, then through all sts on needle. Pull tightly together and knot.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
