## GAUGE:

1 Granny Square $=6 \mathrm{in}$. ( 15 cm ) square. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in . [10 cm ] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## STITCH EXPLANATI ON:

Popcorn Work 5 dc in indicated st, remove hook from loop, insert hook into first dc of 5-dc group, then back into loop of 5th dc and draw loop through.

## NOTES:

1. To change color at end of a rnd, work joining sl st as follows: insert hook in joining st, yarn over with new color, draw through loops on hook to complete sl st.
2. Scarf is made of 16 squares sewn together into a strip. Follow Color Sequence to work squares, changing colors every rnd.

## COLOR SEQUENCE

Square 1: Work Motif 1 working 1 rnd each of L, M, F, B.
Square 2: Work Motif 2 working 1 rnd each of O, D, B, N.
Square 3: Work Motif 3 working 1 rnd each of J, L, N, G.
Square 4: Work Motif 1 working 1 rnd each of $K, C, O$, L.

Square 5: Work Motif 2 working 1 rnd each of $\mathrm{N}, \mathrm{A}, \mathrm{K}, \mathrm{C}$.
Square 6: Work Motif 3 working 1 rnd each of K, H, E, P.
Square 7: Work Motif 1 working 1 rnd each of $E, F, D, A$.
Square 8: Work Motif 2 working 1 rnd each of M, J, F, O.
Square 9: Work Motif 3 working 1 rnd each of G, O, M, D.
Square 10: Work Motif 1 working 1 rnd each of N, G, A, L.
Square 11: Work Motif 2 working 1 rnd each of $A, N, L, E$.

Square 12: Work Motif 3 working 1 rnd each of C, K, D, M.

Square 13: Work Motif 1 working 1 rnd each of $\mathrm{L}, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{N}, \mathrm{K}$.

Square 14: Work Motif 2 working 1 rnd each of D, F, P, J.

Square 15: Work Motif 3 working 1 rnd each of L, D, C, N.

Square 16: Work Motif 1 working 1 rnd each of $O, B, L, M$.

MOTIF 1 (make 6 with colors specified in Color Sequence)
Ch 8; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc of popcorn), work popcorn in ring, * ch 5, popcorn in ring; rep from * twice more, ch 5; join with sl st in top of first popcorn; change to new color.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), ( 2 dc , ch 2, popcorn, ch 2, 2 dc ) in next ch-5 sp, * dc in next popcorn, ( 2 dc , ch 2, popcorn, ch 2, 2 dc ) in next ch-5 sp; rep from * twice more; join with sl st in top of beg ch; change to new color.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, $* 2$ dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2 , popcorn in popcorn, ch 2,2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 5 dc ; rep from * twice more, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2 , popcorn in popcorn, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-2 sp , dc in next 2 dc ; join with sl st in top of beg ch; change to new color.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, *2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, popcorn in popcorn, ch 2,2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 9 dc ; rep from * twice more, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, popcorn in popcorn, ch 2,2 dc in next ch-2 sp , dc in next 4 dc ; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 2 (make 5 with colors specified in Color Sequence)

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in ring, ch 2, ( 3 dc in ring, ch 2 ) 3 times, dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch; change to new color.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in next dc, *(2 dc, ch 4, 2 dc ) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc ; rep from $*$ twice more, ( 2 dc , ch $4,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch; change to new color.

Rnd 3: Ch 3 , dc in next $3 \mathrm{dc}, *(2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 4,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-4 sp, dc in next 7 dc ; rep from * twice more, (2 dc, ch 4, 2 dc ) in next ch-4 sp, dc in next 3 dc ; join with sl st in top of beg ch; change to new color.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, *(2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $4,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-4 sp, dc in next 11 dc ; rep from * twice more, (2 dc, ch $4,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-4 sp, dc in next 5 dc ; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 3 (make 5 with colors specified in Color Sequence)

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2 here and throughout), (3 dc in ring, ch 2) 3 times, 2 dc in ring; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch; change to new color.

Rnd 2: SI st into next ch-2 sp, ch 5, 3 dc in same ch-2 sp, * ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * twice more, ch 1, 2 dc in beg ch-2 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch; change to new color.

Rnd 3: SI st into next ch-2 sp, ch 5,3 dc in same ch-2 sp, *ch 1,3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1 , ( 3 dc, ch 2,3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * twice more, ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch- $1 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{dc}$ in beg ch- 2 sp ; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch; change to new color.

Rnd 4 SI st into next ch-2 sp, ch 5, 3 dc in same ch-2 sp, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, ( 3 dc, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * twice more, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, 2 dc in beg ch-2 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch. Fasten off.

## FI NISHI NG

Sew Squares end to end sequentially into a long strip, $6 \times 96 \mathrm{in}$. ( $15 \times 244 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) long. Weave in ends.
