SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference at Upper Edge: 46 in. (117 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied)

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 (WS): K2, *p8, ~~p4~~ **k4**; rep from * to last 10 sts, p8, k2.

MATERIALS

- 860-133 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Brick
8 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10.5 [6.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Size 10.5 [6.5 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Needles
- Lion Brand Cable Needles (Set of 2)
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

16 sts + 18 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

4/4 RC (4 over 4 right cross) Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k4, then k4 from cable needle.

STITCH PATTERN

Welt Pattern

Rows 1-5: Knit.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.

Rep Rows 1-8 for Welt Pattern.

NOTES:

Wrap is worked back and forth using circular needle to accommodate large number of sts.

NECK STRIP

Cast on 36 sts.

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 (WS): K4, *p8, k4; rep from * to last 8 sts, p8.

Rows 2, 4 and 8 (RS): *K8, p4; rep from *.

Row 6 (RS): *4/4RC, p 4; rep from *.

Row 10 (RS): *K8, p4; rep from *.

Rep Rows 1-10 until piece measures 46 in. (117 cm) from beg, end with Row 5.

Bind off.

BODY

From RS with circular needle, pick up and k 216 sts along purled long edge of neck strip.

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 (WS): K2, *p8, k4; rep from * to last 10 sts, p8, k2.

Rows 2, 4 and 8 (RS): P2, *k8, p4; rep from * to last 10 sts, k8, p2.

Row 6: P2, *4/4 RC, p 4; rep from * to last 10 sts, k8, p2.

Row 10: P2, *k8, p4; rep from * to last 10 sts, k8, p2.

Rep Rows 1-10 until piece measures 5 in. (12.5 cm) from pick up row, end with a WS row.

Purl 2 rows.

Beginning with a k row, work in St st for 6 rows.

Change to Welt Pattern, AT THE SAME TIME, increase 1 st each edge every 20 rows until you have a total of 230 sts.

Work until entire piece measures about 40 in. (101.5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
