Fringed and felted scarf is a fun accessory or a perfect gift for anyone on your list. Easy to knit then just toss in the washer to felt. A perfect first felting project.

Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

Lion Brand® Lion Wool

Fringed, Felted Scarf

Pattern Number: 60662A

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

SIZE: One Size

About 14 x 40 in. [35.5 x 101.5 cm] after felting

CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

- 820-111 Lion Brand Lion Wool: Midnight Blue
1 Skeins (A)
- 820-125 Lion Brand Lion Wool: Cocoa
1 Skeins (B)
- 820-178 Lion Brand Lion Wool: Dark Teal
1 Skeins (C)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 10.5 [6.5 mm]
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

16 sts + 24 rows = 4 in. [10 cm] in St st (k on RS, p on WS) before felting. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

STRIPE PATTERN

Working in St st, work *2 rows with A, 4 rows with B, 2 rows with C; rep from * for Stripe Pattern.

NOTES:

Scarf is knit using a slightly unusual technique to create fringe. After knitting, stitches are dropped to create loose strands and the scarf is felted.

SCARF

With A, cast on 51 sts.

Set-up Row (RS): K 2, bind off 10, *k 3, bind off 3; rep from * to last 15 sts, k 3, bind off 10, k 2.

Next Row: P 2, cast on 10, *p 3, cast on 3; rep from * to last 15 sts, p 3, cast on 10, p 2.

Work in Stripe Pattern in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until nearly all of B has been used, end with a WS row with B.

Drop-stitch Row (RS): With C, k 2, drop next 10 sts from left needle, cast 10 sts onto right needle, *k 3, drop 3 stitches from left needle, cast 3 sts onto right needle; rep from * to last 15 stitches, k 3, drop next 10 sts from left needle, cast 10 sts onto right needle, k 2.

Next Row: Purl.

Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Unravel dropped stitches back to cast-on edge. Weave in ends.

FELTING

Wash by machine on a hot wash/cold rinse cycle with detergent and several pieces of clothing to agitate. Remove from washer and pull into shape. For more about felting, [click here](#).

Trim edge from both long sides of Scarf, allowing the strands from the dropped sts to create fringes.
