## SKI LL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: 12 mos, 18 mos, 24 months (2 yrs), Child 4
Finished Chest $23(25,27,29)$ in. $(58.5(63.5,68.5,73.5) \mathrm{cm})$
Finished Length $12\left(12^{1 / 2}, 13,131 / 2\right)$ in. $(30.5(32,33,34.5) \mathrm{cm})$
Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

7 buttons, $3 / 8 \mathrm{in}$. ( 9 mm ) diameter

## GAUGE:

14 sts +26 rows $=4 \mathrm{in} .(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ in Stripe pattern with larger needles. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## STITCH EXPLANATI ON:

## PATTERN STITCH

K1, p1 Rib
Row 1 (WS): P1, *k1, p1; rep from *.
Row 2: $K$ the $k$ sts and $p$ the $p$ sts.
Rep Row 2 for k1, p1 Rib.

## Stripe Pattern

Rows 1 and 3 (RS): With A, knit.
Rows 2 and 4: With $A$, purl.
Row 5: With B, purl.
Row 6: With B, knit.
Rep Rows 1-6 for Stripe pattern, working Rows 5 and 6 in color sequence as follows: ${ }^{*} \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{D}, \mathrm{E}, \mathrm{F}, \mathrm{B}$; rep from *.

## BACK

With smaller needles and A, cast on $39(43,47,51)$ sts. Work in k1, p1 Rib until piece measures $11 / 2 \mathrm{in}$. ( 4 cm ) from beg, end with a WS row. Change to larger needles and, starting with Row 3 of Stripe pattern, work until piece measures 12 ( $12^{1 ⁄ 2}, 13,13^{1 ⁄ 2}$ ) in. (30.5 (32, 33, 34.5) cm ) from beg. Bind off.

## LEFT FRONT

With smaller needles and A, cast on $23(25,27,29)$ sts. Work in k1, p1 Rib for 3 rows.
Buttonhole Row (RS): Work in k1, p1 Rib to last 4 sts, yo, k2tog, p1, k1.
Continue in k1, p1 Rib until piece measures $11 / 2 \mathrm{in}$. ( 4 cm ) from beg, end with a WS row. Change to larger needles and, starting with Row 3 of Stripe pattern, work 3 rows of Stripe pattern.
Buttonhole Row (RS): K to last 4 sts, yo, k2tog, k2.
Continue in Stripe pattern, working a buttonhole every other Row 6 of Stripe pattern until Left Front measures 10 ( $101 / 2,11,11^{1 ⁄ 2}$ ) in. (25.5 $(26.5,28,29) \mathrm{cm})$ from beg, end with a RS row.

## Neck Shaping

Next Row (WS): Bind off $8(9,9,10)$ sts, work to end of row - 15 $(16,18,19)$ sts.
Working in pattern as established, dec 1 st at Neck edge every other row 4 times - $11(12,14,15)$ sts. Work even until Left Front measures $12\left(12^{1 ⁄ 2}, 13,13^{1 / 2}\right)$ in. $(30.5(32,33,34.5) \mathrm{cm})$ from beg. Bind off.

## RI GHT FRONT

With smaller needles and $A$, cast on $23(25,27,29)$ sts. Work in k1, p1 Rib until piece measures $11 / 2$ in. ( 4 cm ) from beg, end with a WS row. Change to larger needles and, starting with Row 3 of Stripe pattern, work until piece measures $10\left(10^{1 / 2}, 11,11^{1 / 2}\right)$ in. $(25.5(26.5,28,29)$ cm ) from beg, end with a WS row.

## Neck Shaping

Next Row (RS): Bind off $8(9,9,10)$ sts, work to end of row - 15 (16, $18,19)$ sts.
Working in pattern as established, dec 1 st at Neck edge every other row 4 times - $11(12,14,15)$ sts. Work even until Right Front measures $12\left(12^{1 / 2}, 13,13^{1 / 2}\right)$ in. $(30.5(32,33,34.5) \mathrm{cm})$ from beg. Bind off.



## SLEEVE (make 2)

With smaller needles and A, cast on $19(21,23,25)$ sts. Work in k1, p1 Rib until piece measures $11 / 2 \mathrm{in}$. ( 4 cm ) from beg. Change to larger needles and, starting with Row 3, continue in Stripe pattern AND AT THE SAME TIME, increase 1 st each edge every 3rd (3rd, 4th, 4th) row $9(9,10,10)$ times - $37(39,43,45)$ sts. Work even in Stripe pattern until Sleeve measures $7(8,912,11)$ in. (18 $(20.5,24,28) \mathrm{cm})$ from beg. Bind off.


## FI NISHI NG

Sew shoulder seams.

## Collar

From RS with smaller needles and A, pick up and k $19(19,20,21)$ sts along Right Front neck edge, $21(23,23,25)$ sts across Back neck, and 19 (19, 20, 21) along Left Front neck edge - $59(61,63,67)$ sts. Work Row 1 of k1, p1 Rib.

Buttonhole Row (RS): Work in k1, p1 Rib to last 4 sts, yo, k2tog, p1, k1.
Continue in k 1 , p1 Rib until Collar measures $21 / 2 \mathrm{in}$. 6.5 cm ) from beg, end with a WS row. Rep Buttonhole Row. Work 2 rows in k1, pl Rib. Bind off in rib.

## Front Edging

From RS with smaller needles and A, pick up and $k 53(55,57,59)$ sts along Left Front edge. Bind off. Rep for Right Front edge.
Sew Sleeves to body. Sew side and Sleeve seams. Sew buttons opposite buttonholes. Weave in ends.
