3 Balls (A)
- 860-125 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Taupe
2 Balls (B)
- 860-135 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Rust
2 Balls (C)
- 860-133 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Brick
3 Balls (D)
- 860-174 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Olive
2 Balls (E)
- 860-170 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Pea Green
2 Balls (F)
- 860-099 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Linen
2 Balls (G)
- 860-140 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Dusty Rose
2 Balls (H)

- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

12 hdc + 10 rows = 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Hdc3tog (Yo, insert hook in next st and draw up a lp) 3 times, yo, draw yarn through all 7 lps on hook.

Hdc5tog (Yo, insert hook in next st and draw up a lp) 5 times, yo, draw yarn through all 11 lps on hook.

NOTES:

1. When changing colors between rows, unused color can be carried along the side of the work.
2. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over, yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch.

AFGHAN

Small Square

(Make 80 Small Squares using colors noted in the assembly diagram below)

With first color, ch 35.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each ch across – 33 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 15 hdc, hdc3tog, hdc in next 15 hdc; change to second color in last st – 31 hdc.

Row 3: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 13 hdc, hdc5tog, hdc in next 13 hdc – 27 hdc.

Row 4: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 12 hdc, hdc3tog, hdc in next 12 hdc; change to first color in last st – 25 hdc.

Row 5: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 11 hdc, hdc3tog, hdc in next 11 hdc – 23 hdc.

Row 6: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 10 hdc, hdc3tog, hdc in next 10 hdc; change to second color in last st – 21 hdc.

Row 7: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 8 hdc, hdc5tog, hdc in next 8 hdc – 17 hdc.

Row 8: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 7 hdc, hdc3tog, hdc in next 7 hdc; change to first color in last st – 15 hdc.

Row 9: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 6 hdc, hdc3tog, hdc in next 6 hdc – 13 hdc.

Row 10: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 5 hdc, hdc3tog, hdc in next 5 hdc; change to second color in last st – 11 hdc.

Row 11: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 3 hdc, hdc5tog, hdc in next 3 hdc – 7 hdc.

Row 12: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 2 hdc, hdc3tog, hdc in next 2 hdc; change to first color in last st – 5 hdc.

Row 13: Ch 2, turn, hdc in next hdc, hdc3tog, hdc in next hdc – 3 hdc.

Row 14: Ch 2, turn, hdc3tog – 1 hdc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following assembly diagram below, sew 4 Small Squares together to make each large square. Sew large squares together to make Afghan.

Border

Rnd 1: Join D in any stitch along edge of Afghan, ch 2, work hdc evenly spaced around entire Afghan, working 3 hdc in each corner; join with sl st in first hdc. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join A in any stitch of edge of Afghan, ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; working 5 hdc in each corner; join with sl st in first hdc. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join D in any stitch of edge of Afghan, ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; working 3 hdc in each corner; join with sl st in first hdc. Fasten off.
