#### SIZE:

**Finished Sizes:** S (M, L/1X) **Finished Circumference:** 64 (72, 80) in. [162.5 (183, 203) cm] at lower edge **Finished Length:** 12 (13 1/2, 16) in. [30.5 (34.5, 40.5) cm]

#### MATERIALS

- 790-385 <u>Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Fuchsia</u> 1 Ball (A)
- 790-381 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Barley 1 Ball (B)
- 790-335 <u>Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Prairie</u> 1 Ball (C)
- 790-402 <u>Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Dusty Blue</u> 1 Ball (D)
- 790-395 <u>Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Meadow</u> 1 Ball (E)
- 790-399 <u>Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Apple Green</u> 1 Ball (F)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size N-13
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size K-10.5
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

## GAUGE:

6 dc and 5 rows = 4 in. [10 cm] with larger hook. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### NOTES:

- 1) Ponchette is worked from neck to lower edge.
- 2) To change color, fasten off old color and join new color with sl st in beg of rnd.
- 3) Work into sps between sts throughout.

# PONCHETTE

With larger hook and A, ch 40 (45, 50) loosely; taking care not to twist ch, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring. Place marker for beg of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), hdc in same ch as join, hdc in next 4 ch, \*2 hdc in next ch, hdc in next 4 ch; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 48 (54, 60) sts. Fasten off A and join B.

**Rnd 2:** With B, ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), (dc in sp between next 2 sts) around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 3, 2 dc in next sp, \*(dc in next 5 sps, 2 dc in next sp; rep from \* around, ending dc in last 4 sps; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 56 (63, 70) sts. Fasten off B and join C.

Rnd 4: With C, ch 3, dc in each sp around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rep last rnd 0 (1, 2) more times. Fasten off C and join D.

**Rnd 5 (6, 7):** With D, ch 1 (counts as first sc here and throughout), sc in next 5 sps, 3 dc in next sp, \*sc in next 6 sps, 3 dc in next sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in beg ch - 72 (81, 90) sts. Fasten off D and join C.

Rnd 6 (7, 8): With C, rep Rnd 4.

Rep last rnd 0 (1, 2) more times. Fasten off C and join E.

**Rnd 7 (9, 11):** With E, ch 1, sc in next sp, 4 dc in next sp, \*sc in next 2 sps, 4 dc in next sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in beg ch - 24 (27, 30) pattern repeats. Fasten off E and join F.

**Rnd 8 (10, 13):** With F, ch 3, 3 dc in sp between first 2 sc, sk next sp, sc in next 2 sps, sk next 2 sps, \*4 dc in sp between next 2 sc, sk next sp, sc in next 2 sps, sk next 2 sps; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off F and join B.

**Rnd 9 (11, 14):** With B, ch 3, sk next sp, dc in next 2 sps, sk next sp, dc in sp between next 2 sc, sk next sp, \*dc in next 3 sps, sk next sp, dc in sp between next 2 sc, sk next sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 96 (108, 120) sts.

Rnd 10 (12, 15): Rep Rnd 4. Fasten off B and join C.

Rnd 11 (13, 16): With C, rep Rnd 4.

Rep last rnd 0 (1, 2) more times. Fasten off C and join A.

**Rnd 12 (15, 19):** With A, ch 1, sc in next 4 sps, 3 dc in next sp, \*sc in next 5 sps, 3 dc in next sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in beg ch - 128 (144, 160) sts. Fasten off A and join C.

**Rnd 13 (16, 20):** With C, ch 3, dc in next 4 sps, sk next sp, dc in next sp, sk next sp, \*dc next 5 sps, sk next sp, dc in next sp, sk next sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 96 (108, 120) sts.

Rnd 14 (17, 21): Rep Rnd 4. Fasten off C and join B.

Rnd 15 (18, 22): With B, Rep Rnd 4.

Repeat last rnd 0 (1, 2) more times. Fasten off B and join C.

Rnd 16 (20, 25): With C, ch 1, 3 dc in next sp, \*2 sc in next 2 sps, 3 dc in next sp; rep from \* to last sp, sc in last sp; join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

# FINISHING

Neckband

With smaller hook, join E with sl st in any sp on opposite side of foundation ch.

**Rnd 1:** With E and working along opposite side of foundation ch, ch 1 (counts as first sc here and throughout), 3 dc in next sp, \*sc in next sp, 3 dc in next sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in beg ch - 80 (90, 100) sts. Fasten off E and join F.

**Rnd 2:** With F, \*sk next sp, sc in next sp, sk next sp, 3 dc in next sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
