# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice

### TV Lapghan

Pattern Number: 70375AD

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size

About 45 x 60 in. (114.5 x 152.5 cm) excluding fringe

**CORRECTIONS:** None

#### MATERIALS

- 860-105 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Silver Blue  
5 Balls (A)
- 860-109 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Colonial Blue  
5 Balls (B)
- 860-108 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Dusty  
5 Balls (C)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size Q-19
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

#### GAUGE:

3 V-sts + 4 rows = 6 in. (15 cm) in V-st pattern with 1 strand each of A, B and C held together. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### NOTES:

Lapghan is worked with 1 strand each of A, B and C held together throughout.

#### LAPGHAN

With 1 strand each of A, B and C held together, ch 67.

**Row 1:** Dc in 5th ch from hook, ch 1, dc in same ch (first V-st made), \*sk next 2 ch, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch (V-st made); rep from \* to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch - 21 V-sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, \*(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 space; rep from \* across, dc in top of turning ch.

**Rows 3-40:** Rep Row 2.

Fasten off.

#### Edging

Holding 1 strand each of A, B and C together, join yarn in any corner of Lapghan.

**Edging Row:** Ch 1, single crochet evenly spaced along long edge of Lapghan. Fasten off. Rep along other long edge.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

#### Fringe

For each fringe cut 3 strands of each color (9 strands total) approximately 22 in. (56 cm) long. Hold the 9 strands together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of Lapghan, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make Fringe evenly spaced along top and lower edges of Lapghan. Trim fringe evenly.
