MATERIALS

- 640-099 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick Yarn: Fisherman</u>
 4 Balls (A)
- 640-178 <u>Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick & Quick: Cilantro</u> 1 Ball (B)
- 640-134 Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick and Quick: Citron 1 Ball (C)
- 640-122 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick Yarn: Taupe 1 Ball (D)
- 640-132 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick Yarn: Lemongrass</u> 1 Ball (E)
- 640-189 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick Yarn: Butterscotch</u>
 1 Ball (F)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size P-15
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

4 1/2 hdc + 4 rows = 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with next color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Carry colors not in use along wrong side of work.

THROW

With A, ch 52.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across - 50 hdc.
Rows 2-3: Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across.
Row 4: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 21 sts; change to C; hdc in last 29 sts.
Row 5: With C, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 29 sts; change to A; hdc in last 21 sts.
Row 6: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 21 sts; change to C; hdc in last 29 sts.
Rows 7 and 8: Rep Rows 5 and 6; change to A at end of Row 8.
Fasten off C.
Rows 9-11: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 25 sts; change to A; hdc in last 25 sts.
Row 12: With E, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 25 sts; change to A; hdc in last 25 sts.
Row 13: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 25 sts; change to E; hdc in last 25 sts.
Rows 14: With E, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 25 sts; change to A; hdc in last 25 sts.
Rows 15 and 16: Rep Rows 13 and 14.
Fasten off E.
Rows 17 and 18: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across; change to D at end of Row 18.

Row 19: With D, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 26 sts; change to A; hdc in last 24 sts. Row 20: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 24 sts; change to D; hdc in last 26 sts. **Row 21:** With D, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 26 sts; change to A; hdc in last 24 sts. Rows 22 and 23: Rep Rows 20 and 21. Fasten off D. Rows 24-28: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across. Rows 29-33: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 7 sts; change to F; hdc in next 36 sts; change to A; hdc in last 7 sts. Fasten off F. Rows 34-36: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across. **Row 37:** With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 36 sts; change to C; hdc in last 14 sts. Row 38: With C, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 14 sts; change to A; hdc in last 36 sts. Row 39: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 36 sts; change to C; hdc in last 14 sts. Row 40 and 41: Rep Rows 38 and 39; change to A at end of Row 41. Rows 42 and 43: With A, ch 2, hdc in each st across. Row 44: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 25 sts; change to B; hdc in last 25 sts. Row 45: With B, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 25 sts; change to A; hdc in last 25 sts. Row 46: With A, ch 2, turn, hdc in first 25 sts; change to B; hdc in last 25 sts. Rows 47 and 48: Rep Rows 45 and 46. Fasten off A and B.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
