# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Homespun® Crochet Ripple Afghan

Pattern Number: 70409AD

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size  
43 x 56 in. [109 x 142 cm]

**CORRECTIONS:** None

### MATERIALS

- 790-394 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Golden  
2 Balls (A)
- 790-401 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Saffron  
2 Balls (B)
- 790-378 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Olive  
2 Balls (C)
- 790-397 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Russet  
2 Balls (D)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

### GAUGE:

1 ripple = 5 1/2 in. [14 cm] in ripple pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**Dc3tog (dc 3 sts together)** Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops. (Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

### NOTES:

To change color work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st.

### COLOR SEQUENCE

Work 1 row with D, \*2 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with D; rep from \* 6 more times, ending last rep with only 1 row of D, for Color Sequence.

### AFGHAN

With D, ch 115.

**Row 1:** Work 2 dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 3 ch, (dc3tog) twice, dc in next 3 ch, \*3 dc in next 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch, (dc3tog) twice, dc in next 3 ch; rep from \* across to last ch, 3 dc in last ch; change to A in last st - 8 ripples.

**Row 2:** With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in next 3 sts, (dc3tog) twice, dc in next 3 dc, \*3 dc in next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, (dc3tog) twice, dc in next 3 dc; rep from \* across, 3 dc in top of turning ch. Rep Row 2, until 56 rows of Color Sequence have been worked. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
