SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference 22 1/2 in. (57.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

- 640-110 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick Yarn: Navy
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

7 sc = 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc dec) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

BERET

Ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 8 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc - 8 sc. Place marker for beg of rnd, move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc - 16 sts.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 24 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 32 sts.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 40 sts.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 48 sts.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 56 sts.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 64 sts.

Rnds 9-14: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st around; join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 15: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 6 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 56 sts.

Rnd 16: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 5 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 48 sts.

Rnd 17: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 4 sts, sc2tog; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 40 sts.

Rnds 18 and 19: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
