39 x 49 in. (99 x 124.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jan 22, 2009)

COLOR SEQUENCE

*Work 3 rows with A, 3 rows with B, 3 rows with C, 3 rows with D; rep from * for Color Sequence.

MATERIALS

- 480-098 Lion Brand Nature's Choice® Organic Cotton Yarn : Almond
3 Balls (A)
- 480-099 Lion Brand Nature's Choice® Organic Cotton Yarn: Macadamia
3 Balls (B)
- 480-124 Lion Brand Nature's Choice® Organic Cotton Yarn: Pecan
3 Balls (C)
- 480-125 Lion Brand Nature's Choice® Organic Cotton Yarn: Walnut
3 Balls (D)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles

GAUGE:

12 sts + 5 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Shell pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Shell Dc in next dc, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) between last dc and next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc.

NOTES:

COLOR SEQUENCE *Work 3 rows with A, 3 rows with B, 3 rows with C, 3 rows with D; rep from * for Color Sequence.

To change color, work last st with old color to last yarn over, yarn over with new color, and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch.

AFGHAN

With A, ch 121.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as dc), *skip next 3 ch, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch, skip next 3 ch, dc in each of next 2 ch; rep from * across.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 here and throughout), turn, dc between first 2 dc, ch 1, dc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, *skip next 3 dc, shell over next 2 dc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last 5 sts, skip next 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc between last dc and beginning ch, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 3: Ch 4, turn, 2 dc in first ch-1 sp, skip next (dc, ch-1 sp), dc in next dc, skip next sc, dc in next dc, *skip next ch-1 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-1 sp, skip next (dc, ch-1 sp), dc in next dc, skip next sc, dc in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc, 2 dc in last ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch; change to B in last st.

Row 4: Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, skip next 2 dc, dc in next 2 dc, *(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-3 space, skip next 2 dc, dc in each of next 2 dc; rep from * to last 3 dc, 3 dc in last ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, *skip next 3 dc, shell over next 2 dc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to end, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

Row 6: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, skip first sc, dc in next sc, skip next (dc, ch-1 sp), (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-1 sp, *skip next (dc, ch-1 sp), dc in next dc, skip next sc, dc in next dc, skip next ch-1 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last 5 sts, dc in each of last 2 sc; change to C in last st.

Row 7: Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, dc in next dc, *(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, skip next 2 dc, dc in each of next 2 dc; rep from * across, working last dc in top of turning ch. Rep Rows 2 through 7, changing colors following Color Sequence until piece measures about 49 in. (124.5 cm) from beg. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
