SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size
About 30 x 30 in. (76 x 76 cm)

CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

- 240-205 Lion Brand Sock-Ease Yarn: Cotton Candy
1 Ball (A)
- 240-203 Lion Brand Sock-Ease Yarn: Red Hots
1 Ball (B)
- 240-204 Lion Brand Sock-Ease Yarn: Lemon Drop
1 Ball (C)
- 240-201 Lion Brand Sock-Ease Yarn: Rock Candy
1 Ball (D)
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- Additional Materials
Crochet hook size D-3 (3.25 mm)

GAUGE:

Square = about 3 1/4 in. (8 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

SQUARE (make 81)

With A, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring, ch 2, (3 dc in ring, ch 2) 3 times; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join B with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, ch 1, *(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1; rep from * 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join C with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, ch 1, *3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, rep from * 2 more times, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join D with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, ch 1, *(3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1; rep from * 2 more times, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew Squares into strips, each 9 Squares long. Sew strips together along long edges. Weave in ends.
