- 790-309 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Deco
  - 1 Ball (A)
- 270-124 Lion Brand Lion Cashmere Blend Yarn: Camel
  - 1 ` Ball (A)
- 860-126 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Chocolate
  - 1 Ball (A)
- 760-136 Lion Brand Lion Cotton Yarn: Clove
  - 1 Ball (A)
- 910-102 Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: Blush

1 Ball (A)

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- 910-098 Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: French Vanilla
  - 1 Ball (A)
- · Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size G-6
- · Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- · Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- Additional Materials Fiberfill stuffing Craft glue

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sc2tog (sc decrease)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### NOTES:

About 4 in. (10 cm) diameter

# **DOUGHNUT**

With crochet hook and A, ch 12.

Rnd 1: Join with slip st to make a ring. Work 2 sc in each ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed - 24 sts.

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rep from \* around - 36 st.

Rnds 3-12: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 13: \*Sc2tog, sc in next st, rep from \* around - 24 sts.

Rnd 14: \*Sc2tog, rep from \* around - 12 sts. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Sew last rnd to first rnd to make Doughnut, stuff lightly before sewing closed. Weave in ends. To decorate, snip B into 1/4 in. (6 mm) lengths and glue to Doughnut for sprinkles or coconut, or glue longer lengths of B on for frosting lines.
