

# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Jiffy® Loch Lomond Afghan

# **MATERIALS**

• 450-098 Lion Brand Jiffy® Yarn: Oat

6 Balls (A)

• 450-121 Lion Brand Jiffy® Yarn: Taupe Mist

6 Balls (B)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size J-10
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

# **GAUGE:**

Motif  $1 = 13 \times 13$  in. (33 x 33 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.


#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**Dtr2tog:** Yarn over 3 times, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times; yarn over 3 times, insert hook in next indicated st and draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times; yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

Picot: Ch 3, sl st in first of these 3 ch to make Picot.

#### NOTES:

To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch.



# MOTIF 1 (make 3)

With B, ch 8; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, work 16 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as hdc, ch 2), \*skip next st, hdc in next st, ch 2; rep from \* around; join with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch-8 ch-2 sps.

Rnd 3: \*Sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, dc in next 7 ch, sc in last 2 ch, sl st in same ch-2 sp of Rnd 2, ch 2, turn, skip sl st and next 2 sc, dc in next st, (ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st) 4 times, sc in beg ch, ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, sc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next st, (dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next st) 3 times, 2 sc in next ch-2 sp, sc in same ch-2 sp of Rnd 2 (petal made); rep from \* around, join with sl st in first sc-8 petals. Fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** Rejoin B with sc in point of any petal, ch 7, dtr2tog over 3rd dc from point of current petal and 3rd dc from point of next petal, ch 7, \*sc in point of next petal, ch 7, dtr2tog over 3rd dc from point of current petal and 3rd dc from point of next petal, ch 7; rep from \* around, join with sl st in first sc-16 ch-7 sps.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, 7 sc in next ch-7 sp, sc in next dtr2tog, 7 sc in next ch-7 sp, \*sc in next sc, 7 sc in next ch-7 sp, sc in next dtr2tog, 7 sc in next ch-7 sp; rep from \* around, join with sl st in first sc-128 sc.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 6 (counts as 1 dc, ch 3), dc in same st as join, (ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st) 7 times, ch 1, skip next st, \*(dc, ch 3, dc) in next sc, (ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st) 7 times, ch 1, skip next st; rep from \* around, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-72 ch-sp.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, (sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp) 8 times, \*sc in next dc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, (sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp) 8 times; rep from \* around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

# MOTIF 2 (make 3)

With B, ch 10; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 5 sc in ring, make picot, (8 sc in ring, make picot) twice, 3 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc-3 picots.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in same st as join, \*ch 12, skip (4 sc, picot, 3 sc), sc in next sc; rep from \*once more, ch 12; join with sl st in first sc-3 petals. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join A with sl st in any ch-12 sp, ch 1, (sc, hdc, 13 dc, hdc, sc) in each ch-12 sp around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sc in next hdc, ch 1, (dc in next st, ch 1) 13 times, sc in next hdc, ch 1, sl st in next sc, \*sl st in next sc, ch 1, sc in next hdc, ch 1, (dc in next st, ch 1) 13 times, sc in next hdc, ch 1, sl st in next sc; rep from \* once more; join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 5: SI st in next sc, (sI st, ch 1, sc, ch 4, sc) in next ch-1 sp, (sc, ch 4, sc) in each of the next 13 ch-1 sps, \*ch 1, sI st in next sc, sI st in next ch-1 sp, sI st in each of the next 2 sI sts, sI st in next ch-1 sp, sI st in next sc, (sI st, ch 1, sc, ch 4, sc) in next ch-1 sp, (sc, ch 4, sc) in each of the next 13 ch-1 sps; rep from \* once more, ch 1, sI st in next sc, sI st in next ch-1 sp, sI st in last sI st. Fasten off.

#### MOTIF 3 (make 3)

With A, ch 8; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 15 dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), (dc in next dc, ch 2) 15 times; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-16 ch-2 sp.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 3 sc in each ch-2 sp around; join with sl st in first sc-48 sc.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, \*ch 6, skip 5 sc, sc in next sc; rep from \* 6 more times, ch 6, skip last 5 sc; join with sl st in first sc-8 ch-6 sp. Fasten off.

Rnd 5: Join B with sl st in any ch-6 sp, ch 1, (sc, hdc, 6 dc, hdc, sc) in each ch-6 sp around; join with sl st in first sc-8 petals.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, working behind each petal of previous round, sc in next unworked sc of Rnd 4, \*ch 7, skip next 5 sc of Rnd 4, sc in next sc of Rnd 4; rep from \* 6 more times, ch 7, skip last 5 sc of Rnd 4; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 7: SI st in first ch-7 sp, ch 1, (sc, hdc, 8 dc, hdc, sc) in each ch-7 sp around; join with sI st in 1st sc. Fasten off.

#### MOTIF 4 (make 3)

With B, ch 5; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in ring, (ch 2, 2 dc in ring) 5 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-6 ch-2 sp.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same st as join, 2 dc in next dc, \*ch 2, skip next ch-2 sp, 2 dc in next 2 dc; rep from \* around, ch 2, skip last ch-2 sp; join with sl st in top of beg ch-24 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp, \*dc in next 4 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-48 dc.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next 5 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp, \*dc in next 8 dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* 4 more times, dc in last 2 dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch-72 dc. Fasten off.

#### MOTIF 5 (make 5)

With A, ch 6; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 15 dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), dc in same st as join, \*ch 1, skip next dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next dc; rep from \* 6 more times, ch 1; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch.

Rnd 3: SI st in first ch-2 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 1, skip next ch-1 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* 6 more times, ch 1; join with sI st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 4:** SI st in next dc, sI st in first ch-2 sp, ch 3, 6 dc in same ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp, \*7 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* 6 more times; join with sI st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

#### MOTIF 6 (make 15)

With B, ch 6; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 14 dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** Join A with sl st in any st, ch 6, \*skip 2 dc, sl st in next dc, ch 6; rep from \* 3 more times, skip last 2 dc; join with sl st base of first ch-6-5 petals. Fasten off.

# FINISHING

Sew motifs together following assembly diagram.

Weave in ends.
