SIZE: One Size

52 x 66 in. (132 x 167.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Nov 10, 2009)

COLOR SEQUENCE

Work 2 rows with C, *2 rows with A, 2 rows with D, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with D, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with C; rep from * 2 more times, 2 *\frac{9}{2}\$ rows with A, 2 rows with D, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with C.

AFGHAN

Row 74-76 91: Rep Rows 2-4 2-7 three more times.

Row 77-88: Rep Rows 2-7 two more times.

Rows 89-91 92-94: Rep Rows 2-4; change to A in last st of last row.

MATERIALS

- 790-311 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Rococo
 - 5 Balls (A)
- 790-400 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Chili
 - 3 Balls (B)
- 790-401 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Saffron
 - 2 Balls (C)
- 790-403 Lion Brand Homespun® Yarn: Earth
 - 2 Balls (D)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size K-10.5
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

3 pattern repeats = 10 in. (25.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

3-tr cluster: *Yo twice, draw up a loop in next st, (yo and draw through 2 loops) twice; rep from * 2 more times, yo and pull through all 4 loops on hook.

4-tr cluster: *Yo twice, draw up a loop in next st, (yo and draw through 2 loops) twice; rep from * 3 more times, yo and pull through all 5 loops on hook.

7-tr cluster: *Yo twice, draw up a loop in next st, (yo and draw through 2 loops) twice; rep from * 6 more times, yo and pull through all 8 loops on hook.

NOTES:

To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over, yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st.

COLOR SEQUENCE

with D, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with C; rep from * 2 more times, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with D, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with D, 2 rows with C.

AFGHAN

With C, ch 106.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across-105 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, * skip next 3 sc, 7 tr in next sc, skip next 3 sc, sc in next sc; rep from * 12 more times; change to A in last st.

Row 3: Ch 4, turn, skip first sc, 3-tr cluster over next 3 sts, ch 3, *sc in next st, ch 3, 7-tr cluster over next 7 sts, ch 3; rep from * 11 more times, sc in next st, ch 3, 4-tr cluster over last 4 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in first cluster, *3 sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next cluster; rep from * 12 more times; change to D in last st.

Row 5 and 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across; change to A in last st.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Continue in Color Sequence throughout.

Rows 8-25: Rep Rows 2-7 three more times.

Rows 26-73 Rep Rows 2-25 two more times.

Row 74-91: Rep Rows 2-7 three more times.

Rows 92-94: Rep Rows 2-4; change to A in last st of last row.

Do not fasten off.

EDGING

Rnd 1: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in next 104 sc, 3 sc in next sc (corner made); work 135 sc evenly along side edge; working along opposite side of foundation ch, 3 sc in first ch (corner made); sc in next 103 ch, 3 sc in last ch (corner made); work 135 sc evenly along opposite side edge, 2 sc in same st as first sc of rnd (corner completed); join with sl st in first sc-488 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in each corner st; join with sl st in first sc; change to B in join-496 sc.

Rnd 3: With B, rep Rnd 2-504 sc.

Rnd 4: Turn, sl st in each st to corner st, (sl st, ch 4, 7 tr) in corner st, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st, *skip next 3 sts, 7 tr in next st, skip next 3 sts, sc in next st*; rep from * to * 16 more times, skip next 2 sts, 11 tr in corner st, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st; rep from * to * 13 times, skip next 2 sts, 11 tr in corner st, skip 2 sts, sc in next st; rep from * to * 17 times, skip next 2 sts, 11 tr in corner st, skip 2 sts, sc in next st; rep from * to * 17 times, skip next 2 sts, 11 tr in corner st, skip 2 sts, sc in next st; rep from * to * 13 times, skip next 2 sts, 3 tr in same st as first tr; join with sl st in top of beginning ch; change to A in join -528 sts.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in same st as join, *ch 3, 7-tr cluster over next 7 sts, ch 3, sc in next st*; rep from * 13 more times, ch 3, 3-tr cluster over next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in next st; rep from * to * 18 times, ch 3, 3-tr cluster over next 3 sts, ch 3, sc in next st; rep from * to * 18 times, ch 3, 3-tr cluster over next 3 sts, ch 3; join with sl st in first sc-544 sts.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, turn, 3 sc in next ch-sp, 3 sc in corner, 3 sc in next ch-sp, sc in next sc, *3 sc in next ch-sp, sc in next sc; rep from * around, working 3 sc in each corner cluster; join with sl st in first sc; change to D in join.

Rnds 7 and 8: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in each corner st; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
