## Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

### Lion Brand® Lion Cotton Daffodil Pencil

Pattern Number: 80314AD

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size  
To fit standard pencil.

**CORRECTIONS:** None

#### MATERIALS

- 760-157 Lion Brand Lion Cotton Yarn: Sunflower  
1 Ball (A)
- 760-180 Lion Brand Lion Cotton Yarn: Evergreen  
1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size E-4
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
Standard Pencil

#### PETALS

With A, ch 4, join with sl st to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 5, \*sc in ring, ch 3, rep from \* 4 more times. Join with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch.

**Rnd 2:** \*(Sc, hdc, 3 dc, hdc, sc) in next ch-3 sp, rep from \* 5 more times. Join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

#### TRUMPET

Note: Rnds 1-6 of Trumpet are worked in continuous rnds. Do not join; mark beg of rnds.

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Place marker for beg of rnd, move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

**Rnds 3-7:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 4, \*sc in next st, ch 4, rep from \* around. Join with sl st in same sp as beg ch. Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

##### Stem

Join B by working a sl st around pencil, just below eraser end. Work sc around pencil to just before pencil tip. Fasten off. Twist sts to create a spiral around pencil. Weave in ends.

Leaving centers open, sew Trumpet to center of Petals.

Weave in ends. Slide assembled Daffodil over eraser end of pencil.
