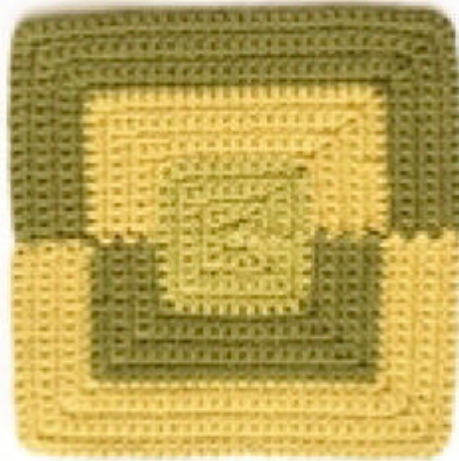

## Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

### Lion Brand® Lion® Cotton Square Washcloth

Pattern Number: 80295AD

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size  
About 8 in. (20.5 cm) across

**CORRECTIONS:** None

#### MATERIALS

- 760-134 Lion Brand Lion Cotton Yarn: Avocado  
1 Ball (A)
- 760-159 Lion Brand Lion Cotton Yarn: Mustard  
1 Ball (B)
- 760-180 Lion Brand Lion Cotton Yarn: Evergreen  
1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

#### GAUGE:

17 sc = 4 in. (10 cm)

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### NOTES:

To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch.

#### WASHCLOTH

With A, ch 4, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 4 sc in ring, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 3 sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 12 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, 3 sc in next sc, \* sc in each of the next 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from \* twice more, sc in last sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 20 sc.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 2 sc, 3 sc in next sc, \* sc in each of the next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from \* twice more, sc in each of the last 2 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 28 sc.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc, \* sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from \* twice more, sc in each of the last 3 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 36 sc.

**Rnd 6:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

Change to B.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 4 sc, change to C, sc in each of the next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 4 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 44 sc.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 10 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 5 sc, change to B, sc in each of the next 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 10 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 5 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 52 sc.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 12 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 6 sc, change to C, sc in each of the next 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 12 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 6 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 60 sc.

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 7 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 14 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 7 sc, change to B, sc in each of the next 7 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 14 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 7 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 68 sc.

**Rnd 11:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 16 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 8 sc, change to C, sc in each of the next 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 16 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 8 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 76 sc.

**Rnd 12:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 9 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 18 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 9 sc, change to B, sc in each of the next 9 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 18 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 9 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 84 sc.

Change to C.

**Rnd 13:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 10 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 20 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 10 sc, change to B, sc in each of the next 10 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 20 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 10 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 92 sc.

**Rnd 14:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 11 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 22 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 11 sc, change to C, sc in each of the next 11 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 22 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 11 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 100 sc.

**Rnd 15:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 50 sc, change to B, sc in each of the last 50 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn.

**Rnd 16:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 12 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 24 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 12 sc, change to C, sc in each of the next 12 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 24 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 12 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 108 sc.

**Rnd 17:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 13 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 26 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 13 sc, change to B, sc in each of the next 13 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 26 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 13 sc, join with sl st in first sc, turn - 116 sc.

**Rnd 18:** Ch 1, sc in each of the first 14 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 28 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 14 sc, change to C, sc in each of the next 14 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the next 28 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each of the last 14 sc, join with sl st in first sc - 124 sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
