SIZE: One Size

About 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm).

**CORRECTIONS: None** 

#### **MATERIALS**

- 820-099 Lion Brand Lion Wool Yarn: Winter White
  - 1 Ball (A)
- 820-125 Lion Brand Lion Wool Yarn: Cocoa
  - 1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size G-6
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- · Additional Materials
  - 2 plastic safety eyes, 9 mm diameter
  - Fiberfill stuffing
  - · Small amounts of black and gray yarn

## GAUGE:

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sc2tog (sc decrease)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## NOTES:

Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.

#### BODY

Beg at top of head, with A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around - 12 sts.

Rnd 3: \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rep from \* around -18 sts.

Rnd 4: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, rep from \* around – 24 sts.

Rnd 5: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* around – 30 sts.

Rnd 6: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 4 sts, rep from \* around – 36 sts.

Rnd 7: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 5 sts, rep from \* around – 42 sts.

Rnds 8-25: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

#### **FACE**

With B, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around - 12 sts.

Rnd 3: \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rep from \* around – 18 sts.

Rnd 4: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, rep from \* around - 24 sts.

Rnd 5: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* around – 30 sts.

Rnd 6: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 4 sts, rep from \* around – 36 sts.

Rnd 7: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

## LEGS (make 4)

With B, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around - 12 sts.

Rnds 3-6: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

### EARS (make 2)

With B, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 4 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rep from \* around – 6 sts.

Rnd 3: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, rep from \* around – 8 sts.

Rnd 4: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* around – 10 sts.

Rnd 5: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 4 sts, rep from \* around – 12 sts.

Rnd 6: \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 5 sts, rep from \* around – 14 sts.

Rnd 7: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

## TAIL

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 4 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 8 sts.

Rnds 3-7: Sc in each st. Change to A.

Rnds 8-15: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

#### Felting

Wash pieces by machine on a hot wash/cold rinse cycle with detergent and several pieces of clothing to agitate. Gently pull into shape and allow to dry.

Stuff and sew Body closed. Sew Legs, Ears and Tail to Body. Following package directions, attach safety eyes to Face. With grey yarn, outline eyes with straight sts. With black yarn, embroider straight st nose and mouth on Face. Sew Face to Body.
