SIZE: Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X

Finished Bust 37 (40, 43, 47, 51) in. (94 (101.5, 109, 119.5, 129.5) cm) **Finished Length** 23 1/2 (24, 24, 24 1/2, 25) in. (59.5 (61, 61, 62, 63.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 861-170 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour®: Topaz</u> 5 (6, 7, 8, 8) Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 5 [3.75 mm]
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles

GAUGE:

22 sts + 32 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

K1, p1 Rib

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts. Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

SWEATER BACK

Cast on 92 (100, 106, 118, 126) sts.

Work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg, increase 10 (10, 12, 12, 14) sts evenly spaced across last row – 102 (110, 118, 130, 140) sts. Change to St st (k on RS, p on WS) and work until piece measures 14 (14, 14, 14, 14 1/2) in. (35.5 (35.5, 35.5, 35.5, 36.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armholes

Bind off 6 (6, 8, 9, 9) sts at beg of next 2 rows – 90 (98, 102, 112, 122) sts. Dec 1 st each side every other row 4 (6, 7, 9, 11) times – 82 (86, 88, 94, 100) sts. Work until armhole measures 8 1/2 (9, 9, 9 1/2, 9 1/2) in. (21.5 (23, 23, 24, 24) cm), end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

K27 (28, 28, 30, 33), bind off center 28 (30, 32, 34, 34) sts, k to end of row.

Left Shoulder

Working on left shoulder sts only, continue as follows:

Row 1 (WS): Bind off 7 (7, 7, 7, 8) sts, p to end of row.

Row 2: Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, k to end of row.

Row 3: Bind off 7 (7, 7, 7, 8) sts, p to end of row.

Row 4: Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, k to end of row.

Bind off remaining 7 (8, 8, 8, 9) sts.

Right Shoulder

Rejoin varn to work right shoulder.


Row 1 (WS): Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, p to end of row.

Row 2: Bind off 7 (7, 7, 7, 8) sts, k to end of row.

Row 3: Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, p to end of row.

Row 4: Bind off 7 (7, 7, 7, 8) sts, k to end of row. Purl 1

row. Bind off remaining 7 (8, 8, 8, 9) sts.



FRONT

Work same as Back until armhole measures 6 1/4 (6 3/4, 6, 6 1/2, 6 1/2) in. (16 (17, 15, 16, 16) cm), end with a WS row – 82 (86, 88, 94, 100) sts.

Shape Neck

K33 (34, 34, 35, 38), bind off next 16 (18, 20, 24, 24) sts, k to end of row.

Right Shoulder

Working on right shoulder sts only, purl 1 row.

Bind off 2 sts at beg of next RS row 4 (4, 3, 3, 3) times. At same edge, dec 1 st every other row 4 (4, 6, 6, 6) times – 21 (22, 22, 23, 26) sts. Purl 1 row. Knit 1 row.

Row 1 (WS): Bind off 7 (7, 7, 7, 8) sts, p to end of row.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Bind off 7 (7, 7, 8, 9) sts, p to end of row.

Row 4: Knit.

Bind off remaining 7 (8, 8, 8, 9) sts.

Left Shoulder

Rejoin yarn to work Left Shoulder.

Bind off 2 sts at the beg of every WS row 4 (4, 3, 3, 3) times. Dec 1 st at beg of every WS row 4 (4, 6, 6, 6) times – 21 (22, 22, 23, 26) sts. Knit 1 row. Purl 1 row.


Row 1 (RS): Bind off 7 (7, 7, 7, 8) sts, k to end of row.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Bind off 7 (7, 7, 8, 9) sts, k to end of row.

Row 4: Purl.

Bind off remaining 7 (8, 8, 8, 9) sts.




Cast on 46 (48, 52, 56, 58) sts.

Work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg, inc 7 (7, 6, 6, 7) sts evenly spaced across last row – 53 (55, 58, 62, 65) sts.

Knit 1 row, purl 1 row.

Next Row: Knit, inc 1 st each side – 55 (57, 60, 64, 67) sts.



Continue to work in St st, AT THE SAME TIME, inc 1 st each side every 6 rows 11 (11, 11, 12, 12) times – 77 (79, 82, 88, 91) sts. Work until piece measures 11 (11, 11 1/2, 11 1/2, 11 1/2) in. (28 (28, 29, 29, 29) cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Sleeve Cap

Bind off 6 (6, 7, 9, 9) sts at beg of the next 2 rows – 65 (67, 68, 70, 73) sts.


Dec 1 st each side every other row 5 (6, 6, 5, 7) times – 55 (55, 56, 60, 59) sts.

Dec 1 st each side every 4th row 6 (6, 6, 7, 6) times – 43 (43, 44, 46, 47) sts.

Dec 1 st each side every other row 3 times – 37 (37, 38, 40, 41) sts.

Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 4 rows; 8 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Bind off remaining 9 (9, 10, 12, 13) sts.



FINISHING

Sew left shoulder seam.

Neckband: From RS, join yarn at right shoulder and pick up and k40 (42, 44, 46, 46) sts along Back neck, 50 (54, 58, 62, 62) sts along Front neck – 90 (96, 102, 108, 108) sts.

Work 5 rows in K1, p1 Rib.

Bind off.

Sew right shoulder and neckband seam. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams. Weave in ends.
