**Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn**  
**Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Chunky**  
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**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size  
About 10 in. (40 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** None

**MATERIALS**

- 630-127 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Chunky Yarn: Walnut  
1 Ball (A)
- 630-173 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Chunky Yarn: Willow  
1 Ball (B)
- 630-107 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Chunky Yarn: Bluebell  
1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- Additional Materials  
2 plastic safety eyes, 9 mm diameter  
Fiberfill stuffing  
Small amount of black yarn

**GAUGE:**

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

**STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**sc2tog (sc decrease)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**NOTES:**

Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.

**BEAR**

**HEAD AND BODY**

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first stitch for beginning of round; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

**Rnd 3:** \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around – 24 sts.

**Rnd 5:** \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* around – 30 sts.

**Rnds 6-13:** Sc in each st around. Following package directions, attach safety eyes. Change to B in last st of last rnd.

**Rnds 14-19:** Sc in each st around. Change to C in last st of last rnd.

**Rnds 20-22:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 23:** \*Sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sts; rep from \* around – 24 sts.

**Rnd 24:** \*Sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sts; rep from \* around – 18 sts. Begin to stuff piece. Continue stuffing piece firmly as work progresses.

**Rnd 25:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from \* around – 12 sts.

**Rnd 26:** (Sc2tog) around – 6 sts.

Fasten off.

### **EARS (make 2)**

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first stitch for beginning of round; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnds 2 and 3:** Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

### **ARMS (make 2)**

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 5 sc in first ch. Place marker in first stitch for beginning of round; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – 10 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Sc in each st around. Change to B.

**Rnds 4-6:** Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

### **LEGS (make 2)**

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 5 sc in first chain. Place marker in first stitch for beginning of round; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – 10 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Sc in each st around. Change to C.

**Rnds 4-6:** Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Sew Ears to top of Head. Stuff Arms and Legs lightly and sew to Body. With black yarn, embroider nose. Weave in ends.
