**SIZE:** Varies, 24 months (2 yrs), Child 4, Child 5-6, Child 7-8, Child 9-10, Child 11-12, Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X

**Child Sizes** 2 (4, 6-8, 10-12)

**Finished Chest** 26 (29, 32, 35) in. (66 (73.5, 81.5, 89) cm)

**Finished Length** 15 1/2 (16 1/2, 17 1/2, 18 1/2) in. (39.5 (42, 44.5, 47) cm)

**Adult Sizes** S (M, L, 1X, 2X, 3X)

**Finished Chest** 39 (41, 45, 49, 53, 57) in. (99 (104, 114.5, 124.5, 134.5, 145) cm)

**Finished Length** 24 (25 1/2, 27, 27 1/2, 29, 30 1/2) in. (61 (65, 68.5, 70, 73.5, 77.5) cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When

only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Dec 2, 2010)

## FRONT

Work even until same length as Back to shoulder. Bind off. **Seam Front to Back at shoulders.**

## MATERIALS

- 860-174 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Olive  
4 4, 6, 6, 8, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12,  
14 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 7 [4.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 7
- Additional Materials

*\*Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic  
**400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon  
**402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)  
**Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g), 145 yards (133 meters)  
**Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)*

OPTIONAL



If working Optional Faux Ties and Pocket, add 1 more ball of yarn.

## GAUGE:

16 sts + 22 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with larger needles. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

### **PATTERN STITCH K1, p1 Rib**

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** K the k sts and p the p sts as they appear. Rep last row for K1, p1 Rib.

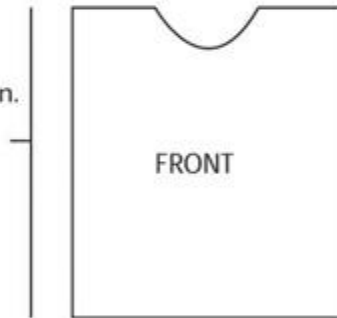

## HOODIE

**BACK** With smaller needles, cast on 52 (58, 64, 70); **78 (82, 90, 98, 106, 114)** sts. Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 4; 6 rows. Work in K1, p1 Rib for 4; 6 rows. Change to larger needles. Work in St st until piece measures 15 1/2 (16 1/2, 17 1/2, 18 1/2) in. (39.5 (42, 44.5, 47) cm); **24 (25 1/2, 27, 27 1/2, 29, 30 1/2) in. (61 (65, 68.5, 70, 73.5, 77.5) cm)** from beg or desired length. Bind off.

### FRONT

Work same as Back until piece measures 13 1/2 (14 1/2, 15 1/2, 16 1/2) in. (34.5 (37, 39.5, 42) cm); **22 (23 1/2, 25, 25 1/2, 27, 28 1/2) in. (56 (59.5, 63.5, 64.5, 68.5, 72.5) cm)** from beg, ending with a WS row.

#### Shape Neck

**Next Row (RS):** K21 (22, 24, 26); **28 (29, 32, 35, 37, 40)** sts, join 2nd ball of yarn and bind off center 10 (14, 16, 18); **22 (24, 26, 28, 32, 34)** sts, k21 (22, 24, 26); **28 (29, 32, 35, 37, 40)** sts. Working both sides at the same time with separate balls of yarn, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge once, then decrease 1 st at each neck edge every other row twice □ 17 (18, 20, 22); **24 (25, 28, 31, 33, 36)** sts for each shoulder. Work even until same length as Back to shoulder. Bind off. Seam Front to Back at shoulders.

### SLEEVE (make 2)

With smaller needles, cast on 26 (28, 32, 32); **36 (36, 40, 40, 40, 40)** sts. Work in St st for 4; 6 rows, then in K1, p1 Rib for 4; 6 rows.

Change to larger needles. Work in St st, inc 1 st each edge of every 4th row 13 (14, 14, 15); **17 (18, 18, 19, 20, 23)** more times □ 52 (56, 60, 62); **70 (72, 76, 78, 80, 86)** sts. Work even until Sleeve measures 11 (12, 13, 14) in. (28 (30.5, 33, 35.5) cm); **16 (17, 17, 18, 18, 19) in. (40.5 (43, 43, 45.5, 45.5, 48.5) cm)** from beg or desired length. Bind off.

**HOOD** From RS with larger needles, pick up and k40 (44, 52, 56); **60 (66, 72, 78, 84, 88)** sts around neck, starting at right side of neck and leaving center 8 (10, 14, 16); **18 (20, 24, 28, 30, 32)** sts free. P 1 row, inc 14 (14, 10, 8); **8 (8, 8, 8, 8, 6)** sts evenly spaced □ 54 (58, 62, 64); **68 (74, 80, 86, 92, 94)** sts. Work in St st for 8 1/2 (9, 9 1/2, 10) in. (21.5 (23, 24, 25.5) cm); **12 (12, 12, 13, 13, 14) in. (30.5 (30.5, 30.5, 33, 33, 35.5) cm)**. Bind off. Fold top edge of Hood in half and sew closed.

#### Front Edging

From RS with smaller needles, pick up and k73 (77, 79, 81); **89 (89, 89, 97, 97, 103)** sts around front edge of Hood. Work in K1, p1 Rib for 4; **6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8)** rows. Work in St st for 4; **6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8)** rows. Bind off with larger needle. Sew edges together at center of neck, overlapping edges (left over right for male; right over left for female).

### FINISHING

Mark 6 1/2 (7, 7 1/2, 7 3/4) in. (16.5 (18, 19, 19.5) cm); **8 3/4 (9, 9 1/2, 9 3/4, 10, 10 3/4) in. (22 (23, 24, 25, 25.5, 27.5) cm)** down from each shoulder seam. Sew Sleeves to Body between these markers. Sew side and Sleeve seams. At roll edge of Sleeves and body, reverse seam to RS for neater roll. Weave in ends.

### Optional Faux Tie (make 2)

With double-pointed needles, cast on 3 sts.

**I-Cord:** \*Slide sts to other end of double-pointed needle and knit them, pulling yarn tightly across the back of the work. (Do not turn work.) Rep from \* to make cord.

Work 18 rows in I-Cord

**Last Row:** K 3 sts together. Fasten off.

Tie overhand knot at cast-on end of cord. Sew one tie at each side of center front of Hood.

### Optional Pocket

With smaller needles, cast on 17 sts. Work in St st for 4 rows. Work in K1, p1 rib for 4 rows. Change to larger needles. Work in St st until pocket measures 6 (6 1/2, 6 1/2, 7) in. (15 (16.5, 16.5, 18) cm); **10 (10, 12, 12, 12, 12) in. (25.5 (25.5, 30.5, 30.5, 30.5, 30.5) cm)** from beg.

Change to smaller needles. Work in K1, p1 Rib for 4 rows. Work in St st for 4 rows. Bind off. Place pocket on center front and sew in place.
