This eerie finger puppet is a scream to crochet during the Halloween season.

## Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

### Lion Brand® Microspun Little Ghost Finger Puppet

Pattern Number: 80769AD

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size  
About 3 in. (7.5 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Oct 10, 2008)

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, \*sc in each of next ~~7~~ 8 sts, ~~\*~~ (sc, dc, sc) all in next st, rep from \* around, join with sl st to beg st - 44 sts.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, \*sc in each sc, (sc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, sc) in dc, rep from \* around, join with sl st to beg st. Fasten off.

#### MATERIALS

- 910-100 Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: Lily White  
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- Additional Materials  
Small amount of black embroidery thread

#### GAUGE:

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sc2tog (sc decrease)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

#### PUPPET

##### Head

Ch 14, join with sl st to form a ring.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each ch around, join with sl st to beg st –14 sts.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st to beg st.

Rep last rnd twice.

**Next Rnd:** (Sc2tog) around. Cut yarn, leaving a long end. Weave end through last rnd, pull tightly together and fasten off.

##### Body

Join yarn with sl st to first rnd of head.

Ch 1, work 15 sts evenly spaced around, join with sl st to beg st.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, \* sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st (increase made), rep from \* around, join with sl st to beg st – 20 sts.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st to beg ch.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, \* sc in each of next 3 sts, inc in next st, rep from \* around, join with sl st to beg st – 25 sts.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st to beg st.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, \* sc in each of next 4 sts, inc in next st, rep from \* around, join with sl st to beg st – 30 sts.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st to beg st.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, \* sc in each of next 5 sts, inc in next st, rep from \* around, join with sl st to beg st – 35 sts.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each st around to last st, 2 sc in last st, join with sl st to beg st – 36 sts.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, \*sc in each of next 8 sts, (sc, dc, sc) all in next st, rep from \* around, join with sl st to beg st - 44 sts.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, \*sc in each sc, (sc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, sc) in dc, rep from \* around, join with sl st to beg st. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With black thread, make a few straight sts for eyes and mouth.

Weave in ends.
