# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® LB Collection Cashmere

### Lacy Luxe Cowl

Pattern Number: 80775AD

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size

21 in. (53.5 cm) circumference, slightly stretched

**CORRECTIONS:** None

#### MATERIALS

- 483-106 Lion Brand LB Collection Cashmere: Cruise  
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- Additional Materials  
Circular knitting needle size 6 (4.25 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long

#### GAUGE:

20sts + 8 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Lace Pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**ssk (slip, slip, knit)** Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog.

**sk2p** Slip 1 as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over—2 sts decreased.

#### PATTERN STITCH

##### Lace Pattern

**Rnds 1 and 3:** Knit.

**Rnd 2:** K1, \*(yo, ssk) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1; rep from \* to end of row.

**Rnd 4:** K2, \*yo, ssk, yo, sk2p, yo, k2tog, yo, k3; rep from \* to end of row, end last rep with k2.

Rep Rows 1-4 for Lace Pattern.

#### COWL

Cast on 101 sts, place marker and join, being careful not to twist. Work in Lace Pattern until piece measures about 9 in. (23 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 4. Bind off.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
