Finished Bust 36 1/2 (40 1/2, 44 1/2, 48 1/2, 51 1/2, 55 1/2) in. (92.5 (103, 113, 123, 131, 141) cm) **Finished Length** 22 (23, 24, 24 1/2, 25 1/2, 26) in. (56 (58.5, 61, 62, 65, 66) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 481-134 Lion Brand LB Collection Organic Wool: Avocado 5 5, 6, 7, 7, 8 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 7 [4.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
 5 buttons, 1 in. (2.5 cm) diameter

GAUGE:

16 sts + 21 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) using larger needles. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH K2, p2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts + 2) Row 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2. Row 2: Knit the k sts and purl the p sts. Rep Row 2 for K2, p2 Rib.

ВАСК

With smaller needles, cast on 70 (78, 86, 94, 98, 106) sts. Work in K2, p2 Rib until piece measures 2 in. (5 cm) from beg.

Change to larger needles.

Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures 4 3/4 (5, 5 1/4, 5 1/4, 5 1/2, 5 1/2) in. (12 (12.5, 13.5, 12.5, 14.14) cm) from beg. and with a WS raw

13.5, 14, 14) cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Sides

Next (Dec) Row: K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog - 68 (76, 84, 92, 96, 104) sts. Work even in St st for 3 rows, then rep Dec Row once more - 66 (74, 82, 90, 94, 102) sts. Continue even in St st until piece measures 8 3/4 (9, 9 1/4, 9 1/4, 9 1/2, 9 1/2) in. (22 (23, 23.5, 23.5, 24, 24)

cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Next (Inc) Row: Knit, inc 1 st at each edge - 68 (76, 84, 92, 96, 104) sts. Work even in St st for 3 rows, then rep Inc Row once more

- 70 (78, 86, 94, 98, 106) sts. Continue even in St st until piece measures 13 (13 1/2, 14, 14, 14 1/2, 14 1/2) in. (33 (34.5, 35.5, 35.5, 37, 37) cm)

from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armholes

Bind off 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows - 62 (70, 78, 82, 86, 94) sts.

Next Row: K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog.


Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 2 (2, 4, 3, 3, 5) times - 56 (64, 68, 74, 78, 82) sts.

Work even until armhole measures 8 (8 1/2, 9, 9 1/2, 10, 10 1/2) in. (20.5 (21.5, 23, 24, 25.5, 26.5) cm), end with a WS row.

Shape Shoulders

Bind off 6 (8, 9, 10, 11, 12) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6) sts at beg of next 4 rows. Bind off rem 28 (28, 30, 30, 32, 34) sts.



LEFT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on 45 (49, 53, 57, 61, 65) sts. **Row 1 (RS):** *P2, k2, rep from * to last 9 sts, (k1, p1) 4 times, k1.

Row 2: P1, (k1, p1) 4 times, *p2, k2, rep from * across. **Row 3:** Rep Row 1.

Rep last 2 rows 2 more times, then rep Row 2 once more. Change to larger needles.

Next Row: K to last 9 sts, sl these 9 sts to a holder for front band.

Continue in St st over these 36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 56) sts until piece measures 4 3/4 (5, 5 1/4, 5 1/4, 5 1/2, 5 1/2) in. (12 (12.5, 13.5, 13.5, 14, 14) cm) from beg, end with a

WS row.

Shape Side

Next (Dec) Row: K2tog, k to end - 35 (39, 43, 47, 51, 55) sts.

Work even in St st for 3 rows, then rep Dec Row once more - 34 (38, 42, 46, 50, 54) sts.

Continue even in St st until piece measures 8 3/4 (9, 9

1/4, 9 1/4, 9 1/2, 9 1/2) in. (22 (23, 23.5, 23.5, 24, 24) cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Next (Inc) Row: Inc 1 st at beg of row, k to end - 35 (39, 43, 47, 51, 55) sts.

Work even in St st for 3 rows, then rep Inc Row once more - 36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 56) sts.

Work even in St st until piece measures 13 (13 1/2, 14,

14, 14 1/2, 14 1/2) in. (33 (34.5, 35.5, 35.5, 37, 37) cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armhole and Neck

Bind off 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) sts at beg of next row - 32 (36, 40, 42, 46, 50) sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next (Dec) Row: K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog. Rep last 2 rows 2 (2, 3, 2, 3, 5) times - 26 (30, 32, 36, 38, 38) sts. Next Row: Purl.

Next (Dec) Row: K to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Rep last 2 rows 6 (5, 6, 8, 9, 8) times, then rep Dec Row every 4th row 5 (6, 6, 5, 5, 5) times - 14 (18, 19, 22, 23, 24) sts.

Work in St st until armhole measures same as Back, end with a WS row.

Shape Shoulder

Next Row: Bind off 6 (8, 9, 10, 11, 12) sts, k to end - 8 (10, 10, 12, 12, 12) sts. Purl 1 row.

Next Row: Bind off 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6) sts, k to end. Purl 1 row.

Bind off rem 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

With smaller needles, cast on 45 (49, 53, 57, 61, 65) sts. **Rows 1 and 3 (RS):** (K1, p1) 4 times, k1, *p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 2: *P2, k2; rep from * to last 9 sts, p1, (k1, p1) 4 times.

Row 4 (begin buttonhole): *P2, k2; rep from * to last 9 sts, (p1, k1) twice, bind off 1 st (for buttonhole), (k1, p1) twice.

Row 5 (RS): (K1, p1) twice; join a 2nd ball of yarn to work other side of buttonhole separately, (p1, k1) twice, *p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 6: *P2, k2; rep from * to 4 sts before buttonhole, (p1, k1) twice, with separate ball of yarn, (k1, p1) twice. **Rows 7 and 8:** Working each side of buttonhole with separate balls of yarn, rep Rows 5 and 6.

Row 9 (complete buttonhole): (K1, p1) twice, cast on 1 st over buttonhole, (p1, k1) twice, *p2, k2; rep from * to end. Continue with 1 ball of yarn only.

Change to larger needles.

Next Row (WS): P to last 9 sts, sl these 9 sts to a holder for front band.

Continue in St st over these 36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 56) sts until piece measures 4 3/4 (5, 5 1/4, 5 1/4, 5 1/2, 5 1/2) in. (12 (12.5, 13.5, 13.5, 14, 14) cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Side

Next (Dec) Row: K to last 2 sts, k2tog - 35 (39, 43, 47, 51, 55) sts.

Work even in St st for 3 rows, then rep Dec Row once more - 34 (38, 42, 46, 50, 54) sts.

Continue even in St st until piece measures 8 3/4 (9, 9 1/4, 9 1/4, 9 1/2, 9 1/2) in. (22 (23, 23.5, 23.5, 24, 24) cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Next (Inc) Row: Knit, inc 1 st at end of row - 35 (39, 43, 47, 51, 55) sts.

Work even in St st for 3 rows, then rep Inc Row once more - 36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 56) sts.

Work even in St st until piece measures 13 (13 1/2, 14,

14, 14 1/2, 14 1/2) in. (33 (34.5, 35.5, 35.5, 37, 37) cm) from beg, end with a RS row.


Shape Armhole and Neck

Bind off 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) sts at beg of next row - 32 (36, 40, 42, 46, 50) sts.

Next (Dec) Row: K2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 2 (2, 3, 2, 3, 5) more times - 26 (30, 32,



36, 38, 38) sts. Next (Dec) Row: K2tog, k to end. Next Row: Purl. Rep last 2 rows 6 (5, 6, 8, 9, 8) times, then rep Dec Row every 4th row 5 (6, 6, 5, 5, 5) - 14 (18, 19, 22, 23, 24) sts. Continue in St st until armhole measures same as Back, end with a RS row. Shape Shoulder Wast Bown Bird off ((0, 0, 10, 11, 12) stars to end off

Next Row: Bind off 6 (8, 9, 10, 11, 12) sts, p to end - 8 (10, 10, 12, 12, 12) sts.

Knit 1 row.

Next Row: Bind off 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6) sts, p to end. Knit 1 row. Bind off rem 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6) sts.

Front Bands and Collar Left Front Band

SI 9 Left Front band sts from holder onto smaller needles. Work in K1, p1 Rib as established until band measures same as front edge to beg of neck shaping; end with a WS row.

Collar - Left Half

Next Row (RS): K9, cast on 10 sts.

Change to larger needles.

Next Row: Purl.

*Next Row: K9, sl 1, k9

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: Inc in first st, k to center st, sl center st, k to last st, inc in last st - 21 sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: Knit to center st, sl center st, knit to end. **Next Row**: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows until there are 37 (37, 37, 41, 41, 41) sts, then rep last 2 rows until Left Collar measures long enough to reach center Back neck. Bind off. ** Place markers on left band for 4 buttons evenly spaced with last about 1 in. (2.5 cm) below beg of neck shaping.

Right Front Band

SI 9 Right Front band sts from holder onto smaller needles. Work in K1, p1 Rib as established until band measures same as front edge to beg of neck shaping, end with a RS row, AT THE SAME TIME, work buttonholes opposite markers as follows:

Row 1 (begin buttonhole - WS): (P1, k1) twice, bind off 1 st (for buttonhole), (k1, p1) twice.

Row 2 (RS): (K1, p1) twice; join a 2nd ball of yarn to work other side of buttonhole separately, (p1, k1) twice. **Row 3:** (P1, k1) twice, work other side of buttonhole with separate ball of yarn, (k1, p1) twice.

Rows 4 and 5: Working each side of buttonhole with separate balls of yarn, rep Rows 2 and 3.

Row 6 (complete buttonhole): (K1, p1) twice, cast on 1 st over buttonhole, (p1, k1) twice.


Collar - Right Half

Next Row (WS): P9, cast on 10 sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: Purl.

Change to larger needles and rep from * to ** as for Left Half of Collar.



9½ (9½, 10½, 10½, 11½, 11½) in.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder and side seams. Sew Sleeve seams. Sew in Sleeves, easing cap to fit.

Sew bound off edges of collar together. Sew bands to front edge.

Fold collar in half along center sI st and sew to neck edges. On WS, sew ends of collar to top of front bands. Sew buttons to Left Front opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends.
