Add an ear of amigurumi corn to your Thanksgiving cornucopia!

Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand, Wool-Ease, Corn on the Cob

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SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size About 5 in. (12.5 cm) CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

- 620-157 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Yarn: Pastel Yellow</u>
 - 1 Ball (A)
- 620-180 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Yarn: Forest Green Heather
 - 1 Ball (B)
- · Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size G-6
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- · Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Additional Materials
 Fiberfill stuffing

GAUGE:

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc decrease) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

NOTES:

Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.

Pattern also available for <u>pumpkin</u>, <u>apple</u>, <u>squash</u>, <u>eggplant</u>, and <u>cornucopia</u>.



CORN ON THE COB

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 3 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around – 6 sts.

Rnd 3: *2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rep from * around - 9 sts.

Rnd 4: *2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, rep from * around – 12 sts.

Rnd 5: *2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from * around – 15 sts.

Rnd 6: *2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 4 sts, rep from * around – 18 sts.

Rnds 7 -16: Sc in each st around. Change to B.

Rnds 17 -24: Sc in each st around. Start stuffing firmly.

Rnd 25: *Sc2tog, sc in next st, rep from * around – 12 sts.

Rnd 26: *Sc2tog around – 6 sts.

Fasten off.

HUSK (make 3)

With B, ch 7.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 6 sts.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sts – 5 sts.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sts – 4 sts.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, Sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sts – 3 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next st.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew first row of Husks to the cob at Rnd 16 (along color change). Weave in ends.
