**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size  
About 5 in. (12.5 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** None

### MATERIALS

- 620-157 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Yarn: Pastel Yellow  
1 Ball (A)
- 620-180 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Yarn: Forest Green Heather  
1 Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Additional Materials  
Fiberfill stuffing

### GAUGE:

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sc2tog (sc decrease)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

### NOTES:

Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.

### CORN ON THE COB

With A, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 3 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each sc around – 6 sts.

**Rnd 3:** \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rep from \* around - 9 sts.

**Rnd 4:** \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, rep from \* around – 12 sts.

**Rnd 5:** \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, rep from \* around – 15 sts.

**Rnd 6:** \*2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 4 sts, rep from \* around – 18 sts.

**Rnds 7 -16:** Sc in each st around. Change to B.

**Rnds 17 -24:** Sc in each st around. Start stuffing firmly.

**Rnd 25:** \*Sc2tog, sc in next st, rep from \* around – 12 sts.

**Rnd 26:** \*Sc2tog around – 6 sts.

Fasten off.

### HUSK (make 3)

With B, ch 7.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 6 sts.

**Rows 2-6:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sts – 5 sts.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sts – 4 sts.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, Sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sts – 3 sts.

**Row 10:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next st.

**Row 11:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog.

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Sew first row of Husks to the cob at Rnd 16 (along color change).

Weave in ends.
