This sparkling, lace, half-moon or half-circle shawl adds a glamorous accent to any outfit.

SKILL LEVEL: Easy +

SIZE: One Size

About 22 x 50 in. (56 x 127 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jan 17, 2013)

SHAWL

Ch 3, sl st in beg ch to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch 3 (does not count as st in this row and in all following rows), 9 dc in ring, do not join. **Note:** The turning ch-3 does not count as first dc in each row. This means that you should work your first dc into the very first st (at base of turning ch-3), unless you are instructed to sk the first st. When you reach the end of a row, do not work into the top of the turning ch-3, unless instructed to do so. When counting sts, do not count the turning ch.

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Row 7: Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, (4 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc) across, end last rep with dc in top of beg ch-3 – 44 dc.

. . .

Row 13: Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, (2 dc in ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc) across, end last dc in top of ch-3 – 77 dc.

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Row 21: Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first dc, dc in each st across – 133 dc.

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Row 25: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sk next dc, (2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 dc, sk next dc) across – 178 dc.

MATERIALS

- 861-170 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour: Topaz</u>
 5 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

18 sts + 9 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

SHAWL

Ch 3; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch 3 (does not count as st in this row and in all following rows), 9 dc in ring; do not join. **Note:** The turning ch-3 does not count as first dc in each row. This means that you should work your first dc into the very first st (at

base of turning ch-3), unless you are instructed to sk the first st. When you reach the end of a row, do not work into the top of the turning ch-3, unless instructed to do so. When counting sts, do not count the turning ch.

- Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, (dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc) across 13 dc.
- Row 3: Ch 3, turn, (2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc) across to last dc, dc in last dc 19 dc.
- Row 4: Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in next dc, (ch 2, sk 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc) across 6 ch-2 sp.
- Row 5: Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, (3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2) across, end dc in top of beg ch-3 7 ch-2 sp.
- Row 6: Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first ch-2 sp, (ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) across 6 ch-2 sp.
- Row 7: Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, (4 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc) across, end last rep with dc in top of beg ch-3 44 dc.
- Row 8: Ch 3, turn, dc in each dc across.
- Row 9: Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first dc, dc in each st across to last dc, 2 dc in last dc 46 dc.
- Row 10: Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first dc, (ch 2, sk next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc) across 15 ch-2 sp.
- **Row 11:** Rep Row 5 16 ch-2 sp.
- **Row 12:** Rep Row 6 15 ch-2 sp.
- Row 13: Ch 3, turn, skip first dc, dc in next 2 dc, (2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc) across, end last dc in top of ch-3 77 dc.
- **Row 14:** Rep Row 8.
- Row 15: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across, increase 2 dc evenly spaced 79 dc.
- **Rows 16–19:** Rep Rows 10–13 132 dc.
- Row 20: Rep Row 8.
- Row 21: Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first dc, dc in each st across 133 dc.
- Rows 22-24: Rep Rows 10-12 44 ch-2 sp.
- Row 25: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, sk next dc, (2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 dc, sk next dc) across 178 dc.
- Rows 26 and 27: Rep Row 8.
- **Rows 28–33:** Rep Rows 22–27 238 dc.
- **Rows 34–39:** Rep Rows 22–27 318 dc.
- **Row 40:** Ch 3, turn, dc in first 2 sts, *ch 2, sk next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc; rep from * across to last 8 dc, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in last 3 dc 90 ch-2 sp.
- **Rows 41–45:** Rep Rows 23–27 362 dc.
- **Row 46:** Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first st, *ch 2, sk next 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, c h 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, c h 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in last dc 103 ch-2 sp.
- Rows 47-49: Rep Rows 23-25 414 dc. Do not fasten off.

Edging

Ch 1, turn, work (sc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, triple crochet in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts) evenly spaced around Shawl. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
