This cozy shawl is great for fall weather.

SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: Adult Medium, 1X
Finished Chest 40 (44) in. (101.5 (112) cm)
Finished Length 25 (28) in. (63.5 (71) cm)
Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Feb 22, 2010)

NOTES

The Back is worked from side edge to side edge. The Fronts are worked from side edge to center front. The neck shaping is worked at the center front of each Front. The remaining portion of each Front at the same edge as neck shaping is the shoulder and is seamed to the Back. About 10 in. (40 cm) on each side of Wrap is meant to cover arms, thus finished chest measurement is less than actual width Wrap.

BACK

Ch 59 (66). **Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across—57 (64) hdc. **Row 2 (RS):** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across. Rep Row 2 until piece measures 25 (28) in. (63.5 (71) cm) **40 (44) in. (101.5 (112) cm)** from beg. Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

Work as for Back until piece measures 16 (18) in. (40.5 (45.5) cm) from beg. **Shape neck Next Row (RS):** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across to last 6 sts, leave remaining sts unworked – 51 (58) hdc. **Next Row:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across. Rep last 2 rows twice—39 (46) hdc. Rep last row until piece measures 25 (28) in. (63.5 (71) cm) **20 (22) in. (51 (56) cm)** from beg. Fasten off.

MATERIALS

- 790-409 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Bourbon 7 (8) Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size N-13
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

7 hdc = 3 in. (7.5 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

The Back is worked from side edge to side edge. The Fronts are worked from side edge to center front. The neck shaping is worked at the center front of each Front. The remaining portion of each Front at the same edge as neck shaping is the shoulder and is seamed to the Back. About 10 in. (40 cm) on each side of Wrap is meant to cover arms, thus finished chest measurement is less than actual width Wrap.

WRAP

BACK
Ch 59 (66).
Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across—57 (64) sts.
Row 2 (RS): Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across.
Rep Row 2 until piece measures 40 (44) in. (101.5 (112) cm) from beg. Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

Work as for Back until piece measures 16 (18) in. (40.5 (45.5) cm) from beg. **Shape neck Next Row (RS):** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across to last 6 sts, leave remaining sts unworked – 51 (58) sts. **Next Row:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across. Rep last 2 rows twice—39 (46) sts.

Rep last row until piece measures 20 (22) in. (51 (56) cm) from beg. Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front, reversing neck shaping.

FINISHING

Seam shoulders.

Edging

With RS facing, join yarn with sl st at a shoulder seam.

Rnds 1 and 2: Ch 1, sc evenly spaced around entire piece; join with sl st in first st.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, reverse sc in each st around. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
