## Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

### Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® Flower Garden Dog Sweater

Pattern Number: 80934AD

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** Small, Medium, Large, 1X

**Finished Chest** 18 (21 1/2, 26, 30 1/2) in. (45.5 (54,5, 66, 77.5) cm) around widest point

**Finished Length** 12 (17, 20, 24) in. (30.5 (43, 51, 61) cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

#### MATERIALS

- 640-134 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Citron](#)  
2 Balls (A)
- 640-112 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Raspberry](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- 640-176 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Snapdragon](#)  
1 Ball (C)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size P-15](#)
- [Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

#### GAUGE:

6 hdc + 5 rows = 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**Cl (cluster)** (Yo, insert hook in indicated st, yo and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times, yo and draw through all loops on hook.

#### DOG SWEATER


##### BACK

With A, ch 12 (17, 20, 21).

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (counts as 2 hdc), hdc in each ch to end – 11 (16, 19, 20) hdc.

**Inc Row:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), turn, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in last st – 13 (18, 21, 22) hdc.

Continue to work in hdc, working Inc Row every 1 (1, 2, 2) rows 3 (3, 3, 5) more times – 19 (24, 27, 32) hdc. Then work even in hdc until piece measures 12 (17, 20, 24) in. (30.5 (43, 51, 61) cm) from beg. Fasten off.




**UNDERPIECE**

With A, ch 5.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (counts as 2 hdc), hdc in each ch to end – 4 hdc.

**Inc Row:** Ch 2, turn, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in last st – 6 hdc.

Continue to work in hdc, working Inc Row every other row 1 (1, 3, 4) times – 8 (8, 12, 14) hdc. Then work even in hdc until piece measures 8 1/4 (12 1/4, 16 1/2, 18 1/4) in. (21 (31, 42, 46.5) cm) from beg. Fasten off.

**FLOWERS** (make 3 – 1 with A and B, 1 with B and C, and 1 with C and A)

With first color, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form beg ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, work 7 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off first color.

**Rnd 2:** Join second color with sl st in joining sl st, (ch 3, Cl in back loop of next sc, ch 3, sc into center of beg ring, sk next sc) 4 times; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

**FINISHING**

Sew sides of Underpiece to Back, leaving 2 (2 1/2, 3, 3 1/2) in. (5 (6.5, 7.5, 9) cm) open on each side for legs. Sew flowers to Back.
