# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Wool-Ease<sup>®</sup> Thick & Quick<sup>®</sup> Pocketed October Scarf

**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy

SIZE: One Size

10 x 60 in. (25.5 x 152.5 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Feb 27, 2012)

**Shape Collar** 

Next row (RS): K4, M1, place marker, k to end of row - 21 sts.

**Next row:** K4, purl to marker, k to end.

Next row: K to marker, M1, slip marker, knit to end - 22 sts.

Rep last 2 rows 8 times more - 30 sts. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 35 in. (89

cm), end with a WS row.

**Next row (RS):** K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, k to end - 29 sts. **Next row:** K4, purl to <del>last 4 sts</del>, marker, slip marker, k to end k4.

Rep last 2 rows 9 times more - 20 sts. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 50 in.

(127 cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

### **MATERIALS**

- 640-146 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Fig
  - 3 Balls (A)
- 640-145 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Plum
  - 3 Balls (B)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 17 [13 mm]
- Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

### **GAUGE:**

8 sts + 12 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) over St st (k on RS, p on WS) with 1 strand each of A and B held together. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**M1 (make 1)** An increase worked by lifting the horizontal thread lying between the needles and placing it onto left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop - 1 st increased.

## **POCKET LINING (Make 1)**

With 1 strand each of A and B held together, cast on 12 sts.

Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 6 in. (15 cm), end with a WS row. Slip these sts onto stitch holder.

#### SCARE

With 1 strand each of A and B held together, cast on 20 sts.

Knit 6 rows.

Next row (WS): K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures 8 in. (20 cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Knit 5 rows.

**Next row (WS):** K4, bind off 12 sts for pocket, k3. (There will 4 sts on each side of bind off).

**Attach Pocket Lining** 

Next row (RS): K4, with RS facing, k across 12 sts of lining from holder, k4 - 20 sts.

Next row: K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

**Next row:** Knit.

Repeat last 2 rows until piece measures 16 in. (40.5 cm), end with a WS row.

**Shape Collar** 

Next row (RS): K4, M1, place marker, k to end of row - 21 sts.

Next row: K4, purl to marker, k to end.

Next row: K to marker, M1, slip marker, knit to end - 22 sts.

Rep last 2 rows 8 times more - 30 sts. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 35 in. (89 cm), end with a WS

row.

Next row (RS): K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, k to end - 29 sts.

**Next row:** K4, purl to marker, slip marker, k to end.

Rep last 2 rows 9 times more - 20 sts. Work even in pattern as established until piece measures 50 in. (127 cm) from beg, end

with a WS row.

Next row (RS): K4, slip next 12 sts to a holder, cast on 12 sts, k4 - 20 sts.

Knit 6 rows.

Next row (WS): K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

Next row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures 6 in. (15 cm) above sts on holder, end with a WS row.

Knit 6 rows. Bind off.

Second Pocket Lining

With RS facing, slip 12 sts from holder back to needle. Join yarn and work in St st for 6 in. (15 cm). Bind off.

#### **FINISHING**

Sew Pocket Linings in place. Weave in ends.
