#### MATERIALS

- 830-187 [Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Golden Glow](#)  
2 Balls (A)
- 830-123 [Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Seaspray](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- 830-098 [Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Sand](#)  
2 Balls (C)
- 830-132 [Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Cactus](#)  
2 Balls (D)
- 830-125 [Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Hazelnut](#)  
1 Ball (E)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 7 \[4.5 mm\]](#)
- [Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

#### GAUGE:

18 sts + 24 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

##### Color Pattern

**Row 1 (WS):** With first color, k1, p1, k1; purl to last 3 sts; k1, p1, k1.

**Row 2:** With second color, k1, p1, k1; k1, sl 1 wyif, k1, \*sl 1 wyib, k1, sl 1 wyif, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts: k1, p1, k1.

**Row 3:** With second color, k1, p1, k1; p3, \*sl 1 wyif, p3; rep from \* to last 3 sts: k1, p1, k1.

**Row 4:** With first color, k1, p1, k1; k1, \*sl 1 wyib, k3; rep from \* to last 5 sts; sl 1 wyib, k1; k1, p1, k1.

**Row 5:** With first color, k1, p1, k1; purl to last 3 sts; k1, p1, k1.

**Row 6:** With second color, k1, p1, k1; k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, \*sl 1 wyif, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts; k1, p1, k1.

**Row 7:** With second color, k1, p1, k1; p1, \*sl 1 wyif, p3; rep from \* to last 5 sts; sl 1 wyif, p1; k1 p1, k1.

**Row 8:** With first color, k1, p1, k1; k3, \*sl 1 wyib, k3; repeat from \* to last 3 sts; k1, p1, k1.

Rep Rows 1-8 for Color Pattern.

##### Seed Stitch (over an odd number of sts)

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* across, end k1.

Rep Row 1 for Seed st.

#### SHAWL

With A, cast on 63 sts.

**Rows 1-3:** With A, work in Seed st.

**Row 4 (WS):** With A, k1, p1, k1 (Seed st border), p to last 3 sts, k1, p1, k1 (Seed st border).

**Row 5:** Work first and last 3 sts in Seed st, rem sts in St st (k on RS, p on WS) as established.

**Rows 6-27:** Rep Row 5.

**Rows 28-51:** With B, rep Row 5.

**Rows 52-10:** With C as first color and D as second color, rep Rows 1-8 of Color Pattern 7 times.

**Rows 108-131:** With E, rep Row 5.

**Rows 132-155:** With C, rep Row 5.

**Rows 156-179:** With D, rep Row 5.

**Rows 180-235:** With B as first color and A as second color, rep Rows 52-107.

**Rows 236-259:** With C, rep Row 5.

**Rows 260-283:** With D, rep Row 5.

**Rows 284-339:** With C as first color and E as second color, rep Rows 52-107.

**Rows 340-363:** With A, rep Row 5.

**Rows 364-387:** With D, rep Row 5.  
**Rows 388-443:** With C as first color and A as second color, rep Rows 52-107.  
**Rows 444-467:** With E, rep Row 5.  
**Rows 468-491:** With C, rep Row 5.  
**Rows 492-494:** With C, work in Seed st.  
 Bind off.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
