# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Wool-Ease<sup>®</sup> Thick & Quick<sup>®</sup> Eagle Bay Hat

Pattern Number: 81018D

SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size Finished Circumference About 18 in. (45.5 cm) Note: Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

#### MATERIALS

- 640-149 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Charcoal 1 Ball
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials Double pointed knitting needles (set of 4 or 5) size 13 (9 mm)

### GAUGE:

9 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over Stockinette st worked in the rnd (k every rnd). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### HAT

Cast on 40 sts loosely. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for beg of rnd. Rnd 1: \*K2, p2, rep from \* around. Rep last rnd until piece measures about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm) from beg. Next Rnd: \*K19, k in front and then back of next st (increase made), rep from \* once - 42 sts. Continue in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) until piece measures 9 in. (23 cm) from beg. Shape Crown Next Rnd: \*K5, k2tog, rep from \* around - 36 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Next Rnd: \*K4, k2tog, rep from \* around - 30 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Next Rnd: \*K3, k2tog, rep from \* around - 24 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Next Rnd: \*K2, k2tog, rep from \* around - 18 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Next Rnd: \*K1, k2tog, rep from \* around - 12 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Next Rnd: K2tog around - 6 sts. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and gather tightly together. Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
