**SIZE:** One Size

#### **MATERIALS**

- 860-123 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Beige](#)  
2 Balls (A)
- 860-135 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Rust](#)  
2 Balls (B)
- 860-101 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Pink](#)  
2 Balls (C)
- 860-158 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Mustard](#)  
2 Balls (D)
- 860-173 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Dusty Green](#)  
2 Balls (E)
- 860-140 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Dusty Rose](#)  
2 Balls (F)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13](#)
- [Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

#### **GAUGE:**

Rnds 1-4 of Afghan = 8 in. (20.25 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### **NOTES:**

##### **COLOR SEQUENCE**

Work each round holding one strand of each color together as follows:

**Rnd 1:** A and B

**Rnd 2:** B and C

**Rnd 3:** C and D

**Rnd 4:** D and E

**Rnd 5:** E and F

**Rnd 6:** F and A

Rep this color order for Color Sequence.

#### **AFGHAN**

With A and B held tog, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring, ch 2, (3 dc in ring, ch 2) 3 times; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

**Rnd 2:** Join B and C with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-sp (beg corner made), ch 1, \*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made), ch 1; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

**Rnd 3:** Join C and D with sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, \*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* around;

join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** Join next colors of Color Sequence with sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) across to next corner ch-2 sp, \*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) across to next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

**Rnds 5-23:** Rep Rnd 4 and continue changing color following Color Sequence ending with E and F.

**Rnd 24:** Join F and A with sl st in any ch-sp, ch 1, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp around, working 3 sc in each corner ch-2 sp; join with sl st in beg ch. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
