SIZE: One Size
About 10 in. (40 cm)

CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

- 630-099 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Chunky Yarn: Fisherman
1 Ball (A)
- 630-153 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Chunky Yarn: Black
1 Ball (B)
- 860-133 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice® Yarn: Brick
1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- Additional Materials
 - 2 plastic safety eyes, 9 mm diameter
 - Fiberfill stuffing
 - Small amount of black yarn

GAUGE:

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc decrease) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

NOTES:

1. Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.
2. C is worked with 2 strands of yarn held tog at once. Wind C into 2 balls before beg.

EYE PATCH

Beg at top of Head, with B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in first ch. Place marker in first stitch for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 10 sts.

Fasten off. Following package directions, attach safety eye through Eye Patch.

HEAD AND BODY

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first stitch for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sts.

Rnd 3: *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around –18 sts.

Rnd 4: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 24 sts.

Rnds 5 -18: Sc in each st around.

Following package directions, attach safety eye to left side of Head.

Rnd 19: *Sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sts; rep from * around – 18 sts.

Begin to stuff piece. Continue stuffing piece firmly as work progresses.

Rnd 20: *Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from * around – 12 sts.

Rnd 21: (Sc2tog) around – 6 sts.

Fasten off.

EARS (make 2)

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 8 sc in first ch. Place marker in first stitch for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2-7: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 8: (Sc2tog) around- 4 sts.

Fasten off.

ARMS AND LEGS (make 4)

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 8 sc in first ch. Place marker in first stitch for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2-5: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

TAIL

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first stitch for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2 and 3: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

COLLAR

With 2 strands of C held tog, ch 24. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew Ears to top of Head. Sew Eye Patch to Head. Stuff Arms and Legs lightly and sew to Body. Sew Tail to back of Body. With black yarn, embroider nose. Sew Collar around neck.

Weave in ends.
