## Lion Brand® Cotton-Ease® (new)

### Robot Bib

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size

#### MATERIALS

- 830-123 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease®: Seaspray  
1 Ball (A)
- 830-191 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease®: Violet  
1 Ball (B)
- 830-100 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease®: Snow  
1 Ball (C)
- 830-194 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease®: Lime  
1 Ball (D)
- 830-113 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease®: Cherry  
1 Ball (E)
- 830-186 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease®: Maize  
1 Ball (F)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
Fiberfill stuffing

#### GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not important to this project

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sc2tog (sc decrease)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**hdc2tog (hdc decrease)** Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

#### NOTES:

Work in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.

#### BIB

With A, ch 17.

**Row 1:** 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across to last ch, 2 sc in last ch – 18 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook (increase made), sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc – 20 sts at end of row.

**Rows 3 and 4:** Rep Row 2 – 24 sts at end of Row 4.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Rows 6-20:** Rep Row 5.

**Row 21:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each of next 6 sts, sc in each of next 8 sts, hdc in each of next 6 sts, hdc2tog – 22 sts remaining at end of row.

**Row 22:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each of next 5 sts, sc in each of next 8 sts, hdc in each of next 5 sts, hdc2tog – 20 sts.

**Row 23:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each of next 4 sts, sc in each of next 8 sts, hdc in each of next 4 sts, hdc2tog – 18 sts.

**Row 24:** Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of next 8 sts, hdc in each of next 3 sts, hdc2tog – 16 sts. Work 1 rnd sc evenly spaced around entire outside edge of Bib. Fasten off.

### INNER EYES (make 2)

With B, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch. Fasten off.

### OUTER EYES (make 2)

With C, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed. Work in continuous rnds, do not join or turn.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sts at end of rnd.

**Rnd 3:** \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st, rep from \* around – 18 sts. Fasten off.

### MOUTH

With D, ch 11.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 10 sts.

**Rows 2 and 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across – 10 sts. Fasten off.

### ARMS (make 2)

With E, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed. Work in continuous rnds, do not join or turn.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sts at end of rnd.

**Rnds 3-5:** Sc in each st around, stuffing piece as work progresses – 12 sts.

**Rnd 6:** Sc2tog around, at end of rnd, change to F – 6 sts at end of rnd.

**Rnds 7-10:** With F, sc in each st around – 6 sts. Fasten off.

### TIES (make 2)

From right side, join A with slip st at one upper corner of Bib. Ch 40. Fasten off. Rep on opposite corner.

### FINISHING

Sew Inner Eyes to Outer Eyes. Sew Eyes, Mouth, and Arms to Bib. Weave in ends.
