

# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand Cotton-Ease. Brioche Baby Sweater <br> Pattern Number: 90162AD 

SKILL LEVEL: Experienced

SIZE:
6-12 months (1-2 years, $2-3$ years, $3-4$ years)
Finished Chest $21(24,251 / 2,271 / 2) \mathrm{in} .(53.5(61,65,70) \mathrm{cm})$
Finished Length $12(13,14,15) \mathrm{in} .(30.5(33,35.5,38) \mathrm{cm})$
Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

## MATERIALS

- 830-112 Lion Brand Cotton-Ease: Berry

3 3, 4, 4 Balls

- Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials

Circular knitting needle size 4 ( 3.5 mm ), $36 \mathrm{in} .(91.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) long
4 buttons, $5 / 8 \mathrm{in}$. ( 15 mm ) diameter

## GAUGE:

25 sts +46 rows $=4 \mathrm{in}$. ( 10 cm ) in Brioche Rib. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in . [ 10 cm ] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

BR dec (Brioche right-leaning decrease): K3tog, return k3tog st to left hand needle, sl next 2 sts over k3tog, return k3tog to right hand needle.
BL dec (Brioche left-leaning decrease): SI 2 together as if to knit, sl 1 as if to knit, k2tog, pass the 3 slipped sts over the k2tog.
B inc (Brioche increase) k2tog but do not sl sts from left needle, yo, k2tog over same 2 sts, sl sts from needle.

## PATTERN STITCH

Brioche Rib
Row 1 (RS) : SI 1 wyib, *k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.
Row 2 (WS): SI 1 wyib, *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to last 2 sts, sl 1 wyif, yo, k1.
Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Brioche Rib.

## NOTES:

1. Brioche Rib is a two-row repeat. Only after two rows are completed will you see a new st on one side.
2. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
3. Slip all sts as if to purl, unless otherwise instructed.
4. St counts for RS and WS will differ by one st. Sts should only be counted at the end of a WS row.
5. Back, Sleeves, Left and Right Fronts are worked separately, then joined and worked in one piece for Yoke.
6. With yarn in front (wyif) (with yarn in back (wyib)) refers to the side of the work facing you, not to the WS or RS of the work.


## BACK

Cast on $43(49,51,55)$ sts.
Set Up Row (WS): SI 1 wyib, *sl 1 wyif, yo, k1; rep from * across - $64(73,76,82)$ sts.
Work in Brioche Rib until piece measures $61 / 2(7,71 / 2,8) \mathrm{in}$. $(16.5(18,19,20.5) \mathrm{cm})$ from beg, end with a WS row. Cut yarn and sl sts to a holder.

## SLEEVES (make 2)

Cast on 25 (29, 31, 31) sts.
Set Up Row (WS) : SI 1 wyib, *sl 1 wyif, yo, k1; rep from * across - $37(43,46,46$ ) sts.
Work in Brioche Rib until piece measures $11 / 4 \mathrm{in}$.
$(3 \mathrm{~cm})$ from beg, end with a WS row.
Next (Inc) Row (RS): SI 1 wyib, k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo; B inc, *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to last 7 sts, sl 1 wyif, yo; B inc, sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog, k1.
Next (Inc) Row: SI 1 wyib, sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo, k1, *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * across to last 7 sts, sl 1 wyif, yo, k1, sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo, k1.
Work even in Brioche Rib until piece measures $41 / 2 \mathrm{in}$. ( 11.5 cm ) from beg, end with a WS row, then rep Inc Rows.
Work even in Brioche Rib until piece measures 7 in.
$(18 \mathrm{~cm})$ from beg, end with a WS row, then rep Inc Rows.
Work even in Brioche Rib until piece measures $8(9,10,11)$ in.
$(20.5(23,25.5,28) \mathrm{cm})$ from beg, end with a WS row $-55(61,64,64)$ sts.
Cut yarn and sl sts to a holder.

## LEFT FRONT

Cast on $24(28,30,32)$ sts.
Set Up Row (WS): SI 1 wyif, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, place marker for front band, *k1, sl 1 wyif, yo; rep from * across to last st, k1 - 33 $(39,42,45)$ sts.
Row 1 (RS): SI 1 wyib, *k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo; rep from * across to marker, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1.
Row 2 (WS): SI 1 wyif, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, *k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo; rep from * across to last st, k1.
Rep last 2 rows twice.
Buttonhole Row (RS): SI 1 wyib, *k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo; rep from * across to marker, k1, yo, k2tog, sl 1 wyif, k1.
Continue even in pattern as established, rep buttonhole row every 18th ( 20 th, 22 nd, 24 th) row 3 times - 4 buttonholes total.
Work even as established until piece measures $6(61 / 2,7,71 / 2) \mathrm{in}$. ( $15(16.5,18,19) \mathrm{cm})$ from beg, end with a WS row.
Shape Neck Next Row (RS): SI 1 wyib, *k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo; rep from * to last 11 sts; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1. Work even as established until piece measures same as Back, end with a WS row - $30(36,39,42)$ sts. Cut yarn and sl sts to a holder.

## RIGHT FRONT

Cast on $24(28,30,32)$ sts.
Set Up Row (WS): SI 1 wyib, *sl 1 wyif, yo, k1; rep from * across to last 5 sts, place marker for front band, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, sl 1 wyif-33(39, 42, 45) sts.
Row 1 (RS): K1, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1.
Row 2 (WS): SI 1 wyib, *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to marker, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, sl 1 wyif. Rep last 2 rows until piece measures same as Left Front to neck shaping, end with a WS row.
Shape Neck Next Row (RS): K1, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, sl 1 wyif, yo; BL dec; *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * across to last st, k1. Work as established until piece measures same as Back, end with a WS row - $30(36,39,42)$ sts. Do not cut yarn.

## YOKE

From RS, slip sts from holders back onto needle in the following order; Right Front, Sleeve, Back, 2nd Sleeve, Left Front - 234 (267, 282, 294) sts.

Place markers for raglan shaping on last knit column (marking both the slipped st and the corresponding yo at top of column) of the Right Front, both Sleeves and the Back.
Join Pieces and Begin Raglan Shaping Next Row (RS): K1, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, *(sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog) to 4 sts before marked column, sl 1 wyif, yo; BR dec; plast st of piece tog with first st of next piece (join st); BL dec; rep from * 3 more times, **sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from ** to last 5 sts, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1.
Next Row (WS): SI 1 wyif, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, *(k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo) to join st, knit the join st, yo, (k2tog, sl 1 wyif, yo) to next join st, knit the join st, sl 1 wyif, yo; rep from * to last 5 sts, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, sl 1 wyif.
Work 8 rows even in pattern as established).

## Shape Neck

Next Row (RS): K1, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, sl 1 wyif, yo, *BL dec; (sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog) to 4 sts before marked column, sl 1 wyif, yo; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo; rep from * 3 more times, BL dec, **sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from ** to last 11 sts; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1.
Work 9 rows even in pattern as established.

## Sizes 1-2 years (2-3 years, 3-4 years) ONLY

Next Row (RS): K1, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, *(sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog) to 4 sts before marked column, sl 1 wyif, yo; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo; BL dec; rep from * 3 more times, ${ }^{* *}$ sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to last 5 sts, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1.
Work 9 rows even in pattern as established.
Next Row (RS): K1, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, sl 1 wyif, yo, *BL dec; (sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog) to 4 sts before marked column, sl 1 wyif, yo; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo; rep from * 3 more times, BL dec, **sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from ** to last 11 sts; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1.
Work 9 rows even in pattern as established.

## Size 3-4 years ONLY

Rep last 20 rows once more.

## ALL SI ZES

From RS, place a marker on knit column closest to center (marking both the slipped st and the corresponding yo at top of column) of each Sleeve.
Next Row (RS): K1, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, (sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog) to 4 sts before marked column, sl 1 wyif, yo, *BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo; BL dec; (sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog) to 4 sts before marked Sleeve column, sl 1 wyif, yo; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo; BL dec; (sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog) to next marker, sl 1 wyif, yo; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo; BL dec;* (sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog) across Back to next marker; rep from * to *, **sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to last 5 sts, sl 1 wyif, yo, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1.
Work even as established for 9 rows.
Next Row (RS): K1, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, *(sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog) to 4 sts before marked column, sl 1 wyif, yo; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo; BL dec; rep from * 3 more times, **sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from ** to last 5 sts, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1.
Work even as established, rep last Row every 10th row 3 (2, 3, 1) time(s).
Work $3(3,1,5)$ rows even in pattern as established.
Next Row (RS): Removing raglan markers as you work across row, k1, (sl 1 wyif, k1) twice, sl 1 wyif, yo; BL dec; *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to last 11 sts; BR dec; sl 1 wyif, yo, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, k1. Remove raglan markers.
Work 2 rows even as established.

## Shape Back Neck

Note: Back neck is shaped by working short rows as follows:
Row 1 (WS): SI 1 wyif, (k1, sl 1 wyif) twice, *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to 3 sts before front band marker, sl 1 wyif, turn.
Row 2 (RS): SI 2 wyif, yo, k2tog; *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to 4 sts from front band marker, sl 1 wyif, turn.
Row 3: SI 2 wyif, yo, k2tog; *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to 9 sts before front band marker, sl 1 wyif, turn.
Row 4: SI 2 wyif, yo, k2tog; *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to 10 sts before next marker, sl 1 wyif, turn.
Row 5: SI 2 wyif, yo, k2tog; *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to 15 sts before next marker, sl 1 wyif, turn.
Row 6: SI 2 wyif, yo; *sl 1 wyif, yo, k2tog; rep from * to last 6 sts, turn.
SI last 6 sts to a holder for left front neckband +1 st.
Next Row: Bind off until 6 sts remain for right front neckband +1 st.

## Right Front Neckband

Continue on these 6 sts only as follows:
Row 1: (K1, sl 1 wyif) 3 times.
Rep last row for $31 / 2 \mathrm{in}$. ( 9 cm ). Bind off.

## Left Front Neckband

Slip sts from holder back onto needle.
From RS, join yarn.
Row 1: (SI 1 wyif, k1) 3 times.
Rep last row for $31 / 2 \mathrm{in}$. ( 9 cm ). Bind off.

## FINISHING

Sew side and Sleeve seams, reversing seam about $2 \mathrm{in}. \mathrm{( } 5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) above wrist edge of Sleeve so that cuffs can be folded back. Seam ends of neckband tog then sew edge of neckband to back neck of Cardigan. Sew on buttons opposite buttonholes. Weave in ends.
