

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® Cozy Nook Throw Pattern Number: 90341AD



This beautiful knitted striped throw imitates the look of weaving.

SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

SIZE: One Size

About 35 x 50 in. (89 x 127 cm)

MATERIALS

• Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® (Art. #640)

123 Oatmeal 8 balls (A)

135 Spice 2 balls (B)

Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



Circular knitting needle size 17 (12.75 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long



12 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Woven st. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION

sl 2 wyif (slip 2 sts with yarn in front): Slip next 2 sts to right hand needle, with yarn carried across the front of the work (the side of the work that is facing as you knit).

sl 2 wyib (slip 2 sts with yarn in back): Slip next 2 sts to right hand needle, with yarn carried across the back of the work (the side of the work that is not facing as you knit).

Woven Stitch

Row 1 (RS): K2, *sl 2 wyif, k2; rep from * across.

Row 2: P1, *sl 2 wyib, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 3: Sl 2 wyif, *k2, sl 2 wyif; rep from * across.

Row 4: P3, *sl 2 wyib, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, sl 2 wyib, p1.

Rep Rows 1-4 for Woven st.

NOTES

- 1. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 2. Slip all sts as if to purl.
- 3. Strand yarn somewhat loosely when slipping sts with yarn in front or in back.

Note: The following corrections have been incorporated into the pattern below. We are highlighting the corrections separately here so that if you have printed out an earlier version of the pattern you'll know what was changed.

CORRECTIONS (applied Nov. 25th, 2017)

Woven Stitch

. . .

Row 2: P1, *sl 2 wyib, p2; rep from * across to last st, p1.

<u>THROW</u>

With A, cast on 106 sts. Working back and forth on circular needle, as if working on straight needles, rep Rows 1-4 of

Woven st, changing color as follows:

Rows 1-36: A.

Rows 37-40: B.

Rows 41-48: A.

Rows 49-62: B.

Rows 63-70: A.

Rows 71-74: B.

Rows 75-188: A.

Rows 189-192: B.

Rows 193-200: A.

Rows 201-214: B.

Rows 215-222: A.

Rows 223-226: B.

Rows 227-262: A.

With A, bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

wyib = with yarn in back

wyif = with yarn in front
