**SKILL LEVEL:** Advanced Intermediate

**SIZE:** One Size

About 46 in. (117 cm), at widest point, 21 in. (53.3 cm) at longest point

**MATERIALS**

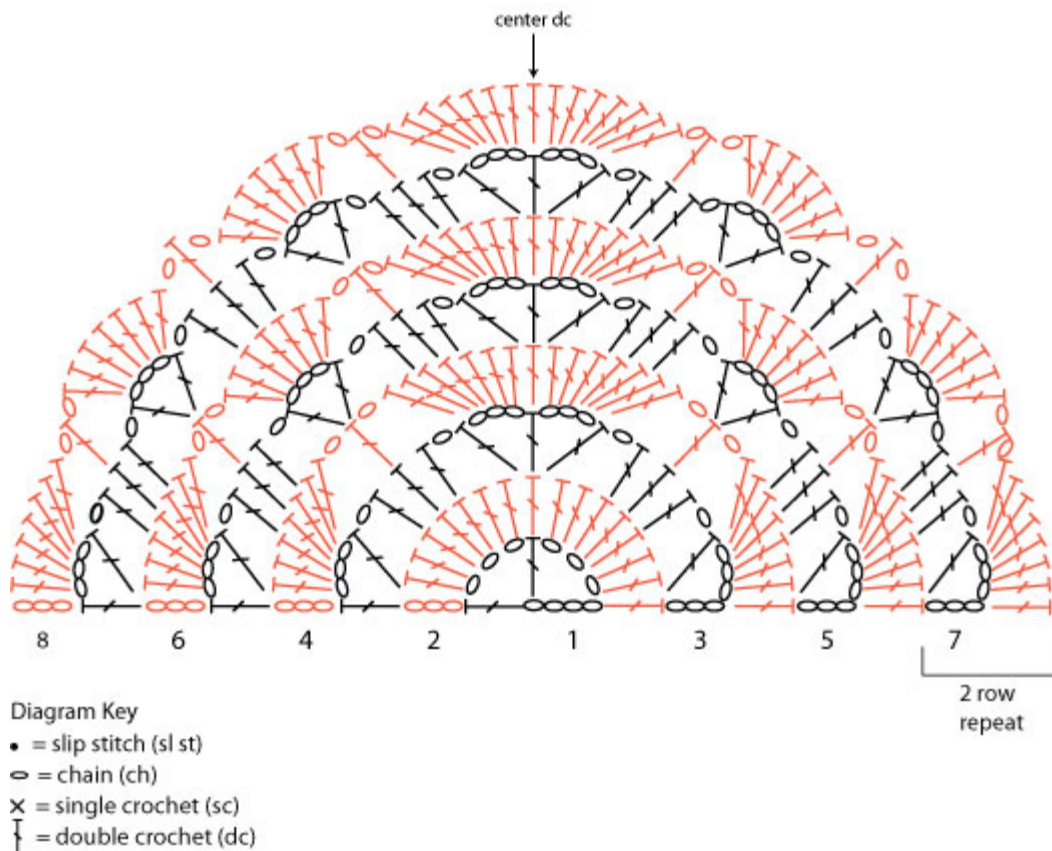
- 484-147 Lion Brand LB Collection Silk Mohair: Iris  
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**GAUGE:**

10 sts + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.  
When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

**NOTES:**

Shawlette begins at center back neck and is worked in rows down to lower edge.



## SHAWLETTE

Ch 7.

**Row 1 (WS):** (Dc, ch 3, dc) in 7th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as dc, ch 3).

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, 7 dc in first ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, 7 dc in beginning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

**Row 3:** Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3 here and throughout), turn, dc in first dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in top of turning ch.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, turn, 7 dc in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, dc in next dc (middle dc of 3-dc group), ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, 7 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, 7 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, dc in next dc (middle dc of 3-dc group), ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, 7 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

**Row 5:** Ch 6, turn, dc in first dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc, place marker in dc just made for center dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in top of turning ch. Move center marker up as work progresses.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, turn, 7 dc in first ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, 7 dc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* to center (marked) dc, dc in center dc, \*\*7 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from \*\* to turning ch-sp, 7 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

**Row 7:** Ch 6, turn, dc in first dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, \*sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc; rep from \* to center dc, (dc, ch 3, dc, ch 3, dc) in center dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, \*\*sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc; rep from \*\* to turning ch, (dc, ch 3, dc) in top of turning ch.

**Row 8:** Rep Row 6.

**Rows 9-28:** Rep last 2 rows 10 more times. Do not fasten off.

## Trim

**Row 29:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, ch 1, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 3 times, dc in next dc, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 3 times, dc in next dc; rep from \* to center

dc, ch 1, sc in center dc, ch 1, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 3 times, dc in next dc, \*\*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 3 times, dc in next dc; rep from \*\* to turning ch, ch 1, sc in top of turning ch.

**Round 30:** Turn, sl st in first sc, sc in each st to next sc, \*sl st in next sc, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp to next sc; rep from \* to center sc, sc in center sc, \*\*sc in each dc and ch-1 sp to next sc, sl st in next sc; rep from \*\* across; do not turn, work sc evenly spaced across top edge of Shawlette; join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
