**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy +

**SIZE:** Adult Medium

**Finished Circumference** 7.5 in. (19 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Jun 24, 2013)

**PATTERN STITCHES**

~~K2, p2~~ **K1, p1 Rib** (over an odd number of sts)

**Row 3:** With B, k1, \*sl 1 wyif (with yarn in front of work), k1, rep from \* across.

**Row 5:** With A, k2, \*sl 1 wyif, k1, rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 9:** With B, k1, \*sl 1 wyif, k1, rep from \* across.

**MATERIALS**

- 822-123 Lion Brand Alpine Wool: Bay Leaf  
1 Ball (A)

*\*Alpine Wool (Article #822). Solids: 100% Pure Wool  
Oatmeal, Barley: 77% Wool, 15% Acrylic, 8% Rayon;  
package size: 3.00oz/85.00 gr. (93yds/85m) pull skeins*

- 822-135 Lion Brand Alpine Wool: Cinnamon  
1 Ball (B)

- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



**GAUGE:**

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

**STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**sl 1 wyif (slip 1 st with yarn in front)** With yarn in front of work, sl next st as if to purl.

**PATTERN STITCHES**

**K1, p1 Rib** (over an odd number of sts)

**Row 1:** K1, \*p1, k1, rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

**NOTES:**

1. Only one color is worked per row. Carry color not in use along side of work.
2. Strand yarn loosely across work when slipping a st with yarn in front (wyif).



## MITT (make 2)

With A, cast on 25 sts. Knit 1 row.

**Row 1:** With A, knit.

**Row 2:** With A, purl.

**Row 3:** With B, k1, \*sl 1 wyif (with yarn in front of work), k1, rep from \* across.

**Row 4:** With B, purl.

**Row 5:** With A, k2, \*sl 1 wyif, k1, rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 6:** With A, purl.

**Row 7:** With A, knit.

**Row 8:** With A, purl.

**Row 9:** With B, k1, \*sl 1 wyif, k1, rep from \* across.

**Row 10:** With B, purl.

**Rows 11 and 12:** With B, rep Rows 1 and 2.

**Rows 13 and 14:** With A, rep Rows 3 and 4.

**Rows 15 and 16:** With B, rep Rows 5 and 6.

**Rows 17 and 18:** With B, rep Rows 7 and 8.

**Rows 19 and 20:** With A, rep Rows 9 and 10.

With A, work 4 rows in St st (k on RS, p on WS). \*With B, work 2 rows in St st, with A, work 2 rows in St st, rep from \* once more.

Cut A. With B, work 3 rows in K1, p1 Rib. Bind off in rib, leaving a long yarn tail.

## FINISHING

Fold piece in half and thread yarn tail into blunt needle. Using tail, sew sides of Mitt together, leaving an opening between B stripes for thumb. Weave in ends.
