MATERIALS

- 860-158 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Mustard
 - 1 Ball (A)
- 860-130 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Honey
 - 1 Ball (B)
- 860-134 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Terracotta
 - 1 Ball (C)
- 860-133 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Brick
 - 2 Balls (D)
- 860-180 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Cranberry
 - 3 Balls (E)
- 860-126 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Chocolate
 - 3 Balls (F)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size J-10
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

13 sts + 7 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

- 1. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st.
- 2. A Square is worked first, then concentric bands are worked along 2 sides of Square to make Afghan.

SQUARE

With A, ch 5; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring, *ch 2, 3 dc in ring; rep from * 2 more times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 2: SI st in next 2 dc, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made), ch 1, *(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made), ch 1; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch – 4 corners at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: SI st in next 2 dc, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, *(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 4: SI st in next 2 dc, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice, *(3 dc, ch

2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch. **Rnd 5:** Sl st in next 2 dc, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, *(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch. **Rnd 6:** Sl st in next 2 dc, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) next in ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, *(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

Band I

Row 1: With RS facing, join B with sl st in dc before first corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, dc in corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) to next corner ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) to next corner ch-2 sp, 2 dc in corner ch-2 sp; leave other 2 sides of square unworked.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) to corner ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) across, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in sp between first 2 dc, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) to corner ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) across, 2 dc in top of beg ch.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 three times. Change to C in last st of last row.

Band II

With C, rep Rows 2 and 3 six times. Change to D in last st of last row.

Band III

With D, rep Rows 2 and 3 seven times, then rep Row 2 once more. Change to E in last st of last row.

Band IV

With E, rep Row 3, then rep Rows 2 and 3 six times, then rep Row 2 once more. Change to F in last st of last row.

Band V

With F, rep Row 3, then rep Rows 2 and 3 seven times, then rep Row 2 once more. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
