- 860-109 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Colonial Blue
 - 1 Ball (A)
- 860-146 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Dusty Purple
 - 1 Ball (B)
- 860-153 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Black
 - 1 Ball (C)
- 860-125 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Taupe
 - 1 Ball (D)
- 860-151 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Charcoal Grey
 - 2 Balls (E)
- 860-158 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Mustard
 - 2 Balls (F)
- 860-180 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Cranberry
 - 1 Ball (G)
- 860-113 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Scarlet
 - 1 Ball (H)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

12 sts + 12 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) over sc; Squares measure about 6 x 6 in. (16 x 16 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

rev sc (reverse single crochet) Single crochet worked from left to right (right to left, if left-handed). Insert hook into next stitch to the right (left), under loop on hook, and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

NOTES:

To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over; yarn over with new color and draw through

Square 1

With D, ch 10.

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 9 sts at the end of this row.

Rows 2-9: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across, change to B in last st of last row.

Note: In the following rows, sc are worked across two edges of the Square (across the last row of sts and then down one side edge).

Row 10 (RS): Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last st (corner made); working in ends of rows, 8 sc evenly across side of Square – 19 sts at the end of this row.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across to center sc of 3-sc corner, 3 sc in corner sc, sc in each st across – 21 sts at the end of this row.

Rows 12 and 13: Rep Row 11, change to C in last st of last row – 25 sts at the end of Row 13.

Rows 14 and 15: Rep Row 11, change to A in last st of last row – 29 sts at the end of Row 15.

Rows 16-18: Rep Row 11 – 35 sts at the end of Row 18. Fasten off.

Square 2

Make as for Square 1, but using A for Rows 1-9, B for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and D for Rows 16-18.

Square 3

Make as for Square 1, but using F for Rows 1-9, B for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and D for Rows 16-18.

Square 4

Make as for Square 1, but using E for Rows 1-9, A for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and B for Rows 16-18.

Square 5

Make as for Square 1, but using D for Rows 1-9, A for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and F for Rows 16-18.

Square 6

Make as for Square 1, but using E for Rows 1-9, F for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and B for Rows 16-18.

Square 7

Make as for Square 1, but using A for Rows 1-9, B for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and E for Rows 16-18.

Square 8

Make as for Square 1, but using B for Rows 1-9, F for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and A for Rows 16-18.

Square 9

Make as for Square 1, but using B for Rows 1-9, D for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and G for Rows 16-18.

Square 10

Make as for Square 1, but using G for Rows 1-9, D for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and E for Rows 16-18.

Square 11

Make as for Square 1, but using A for Rows 1-9, G for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and B for Rows 16-18.

Square 12

Make as for Square 1, but using D for Rows 1-9, A for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and G for Rows 16-18.

Square 13

Make as for Square 1, but using A for Rows 1-9, B for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and G for Rows 16-18.

Square 14

Make as for Square 1, but using F for Rows 1-9, A for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and G for Rows 16-18.

Square 15

Make as for Square 1, but using E for Rows 1-9, B for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and A for Rows 16-18.

Square 16

Make as for Square 1, but using G for Rows 1-9, D for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and B for Rows 16-18.

Square 17

Make as for Square 1, but using B for Rows 1-9, G for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and D for Rows 16-18.

Square 18

Make as for Square 1, but using H for Rows 1-9, E for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and G for Rows 16-18.

Square 19

Make as for Square 1, but using G for Rows 1-9, F for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and F for Rows 16-18.

Square 20

Make as for Square 1, but using E for Rows 1-9, B for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and F for Rows 16-18.

Square 21

Make as for Square 1, but using F for Rows 1-9, H for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and F for Rows 16-18.

Square 22

Make as for Square 1, but using B for Rows 1-9, D for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and H for Rows 16-18.

Square 23

Make as for Square 1, but using G for Rows 1-9, F for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and H for Rows 16-18.

Square 24

Make as for Square 1, but using H for Rows 1-9, D for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and F for Rows 16-18.

Square 25 Make as for Square 1, but using E for Rows 1-9, A for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and H for Rows 16-18.

Square 26

Make as for Square 1, but using F for Rows 1-9, A for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and H for Rows 16-18.

Square 27

Make as for Square 1, but using H for Rows 1-9, D for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and F for Rows 16-18.

Square 28

Make as for Square 1, but using D for Rows 1-9, F for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and E for Rows 16-18.

Square 29

Make as for Square 1, but using F for Rows 1-9, H for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and E for Rows 16-18.

Square 30

Make as for Square 1, but using H for Rows 1-9, D for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and B for Rows 16-18.

Square 31

Make as for Square 1, but using D for Rows 1-9, H for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and B for Rows 16-18.

Square 32

Make as for Square 1, but using B for Rows 1-9, F for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and H for Rows 16-18.

Square 33

Make as for Square 1, but using H for Rows 1-9, E for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and G for Rows 16-18.

Square 34

Make as for Square 1, but using G for Rows 1-9, F for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and F for Rows 16-18.

Square 35

Make as for Square 1, but using B for Rows 1-9, G for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and D for Rows 16-18.

Square 36

Make as for Square 1, but using F for Rows 1-9, E for Rows 10-13, C for Rows 14 and 15, and B for Rows 16-18.

FINISHING

Blocks

Sew Squares together into blocks following Assembly Diagram, as follows: Squares 1-4 for block A, Squares 5-8 for block B, Squares 9-12 for block C, Squares 13-16 for block D, Squares 17-20 for block E, Squares 21-24 for block F, Squares 25-28 for block G, Squares 29-32 for block H, and Squares 33-36 for block I.

Assembly

Note: Blocks are joined from RS of work. Hold Blocks A and B with WS together.

Row 1: Using color to match edge of one of the Blocks and working through both thicknesses, join yarn with sl st in one corner, sl st in each st across edge to join Blocks. Fasten off.

Using colors to match edge of one of the blocks and following Assembly Diagram, continue joining remaining blocks into strips, then join strips to make Afghan.

Edging

Rnd 1: From RS, join E with sl st in any corner of Throw, work sc evenly spaced around, working 3 sc in each

center of Throw; at each corner join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, working 3 sc in each center sc at each corner; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 3 (Optional): Ch 1, rev sc in each sc around, (work only 1 rev sc in each corner sc). Fasten off. Weave in ends.
