 822-106 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Alpine Wool Yarn:</u> <u>Blueberry</u>

5 Balls

<u>Lion Brand Crochet</u>
 <u>Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)</u>

 Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6) *<u>Alpine Wool</u> (Article #822). **Solids:** 100% Pure Wool

Oatmeal, Barley: 77% Wool, 15% Acrylic, 8% Rayon; package size: 3.00oz/85.00 gr.

(93yds/85m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

11 single crochet = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

COWL

Chain 47.

Row 1: Single crochet in 2nd chain from hook and in each chain across – 46 single crochet at the end of this row.

Row 2: Chain 1, turn, working in back loops only, single crochet in each single crochet across. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 50 in. (127 cm) from beginning. Do not fasten off.

FINISHING

Note: If you prefer, you can sew ends of piece together.

Fold piece in half, matching last row to first row. Working through both layers, slip-stitch in each stitch across to join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
