**MATERIALS**

- 860-149 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Silver Grey  
1 Ball (A)
- 860-124 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Toffee  
1 Ball (B)
- 860-141 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Wild Berry  
1 Ball (C)
- 860-170 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Pea Green  
1 Ball (D)
- 860-171 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Fern  
1 Ball (E)
- 830-110 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Lake  
1 Ball (F)
- 830-149 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Stone  
1 Ball (G)
- 830-125 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Hazelnut  
1 Ball (H)
- 830-195 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Azalea  
1 Ball (I)
- 830-187 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Golden Glow  
1 Ball (J)
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
Circular knitting needle size 13 (9 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long

**GAUGE:**

10 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) with 1 strand each of A and F held tog. **BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

**STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**PATTERN STITCH**

**K2, p2 Rib (worked in the rnd, multiple of 4 sts)**

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p2, rep from \* around.

Rep Rnd 1 for K2, p2 Rib.

## NOTES:

Cowl is worked with 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

## COWL

With 1 strand each of A and F held tog, cast on 64 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of rnd.

Work in K2, p2 Rib for 1 1/2 in. (4 cm).

Change to 1 strand each of A and G held tog, and work in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Change to 1 strand each of C and G held tog, and work in St st for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Change to 1 strand each of C and I held tog, and work in St st for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Change to 1 strand each of I and B held tog, and work in St st for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Change to 1 strand each of B and H held tog, and work in St st for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Change to 1 strand each of D and H held tog, and work in St st for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Change to 1 strand each of D and J held tog, and work in St st for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Change to 1 strand each of E and J held tog, and work in St st for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Change to 1 strand each of E and F held tog, and work in K2, p2 Rib for 1 1/2 in. (4 cm).

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
