MATERIALS

- 480-123 Lion Brand Nature's Choice Organic Cotton Yarn: Khaki
2 Balls

- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

- Additional Materials
Circular knitting needle
size 10 (6 mm), 24 in. (61 cm) long

Nature's Choice Organic® Cotton (Article #480). 100% Organically Grown Cotton; package size: **Solids: 3 oz. (85 g), 103 yd. (94 m)
Prints: 2.75 oz. (78 g), 94 yd. (86 m)*



GAUGE:

12 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

K2, p2 Rib (worked in the rnd, multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2, rep from * around.

Rep Rnd 1 for K2, p2 Rib.

COWL

Cast on 80 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for beg of rnd.

Work in K2, p2 Rib for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Change to St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) and work until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beg.

Work in K2, p2 Rib for 1 in. (2 cm). Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
