**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy +

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 26 in. (66 cm)

Finished Height About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Nov 18, 2011)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 26 in. (66 cm) Finished Height About 13 in. (33 cm) 10 in.

(25.5 cm)

#### COWL

With 2 strands of yarn held tog, cast on 80 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for beg of rnd.

Work in K2, p2 Rib for 1 1/2 in. (4 cm).

Change to St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) and work until piece measures about 11 1/2 in. (29 cm) 8 1/3 in (31 5 cm) from box

<del>cm)</del> 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm) from beg. Work in K2, p2 Rib for 1 1/2 in. (4 cm).

# **MATERIALS**

- 825-200 Lion Brand AmazingTM Yarn: Aurora
  - 2 Balls
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- · Additional Materials

Circular knitting needle size 10 1/2 (6.5 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long

#### **GAUGE:**

12 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) with 2 strands of yarn held tog. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### **PATTERN STITCH**

K2, p2 Rib (worked in the rnd, multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: \*K2, p2, rep from \* around.

Rep Rnd 1 for K2, p2 Rib.

## **NOTES:**

Cowl is worked with 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

#### **COWL**

With 2 strands of yarn held tog, cast on 80 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for beg of rnd. Work in K2, F2 Rib for 1 F3 In. (4 cm).

Change to St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) and work until piece measures about 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm) from beg. Work in K2, p2 Rib for 1 1/2 in. (4 cm). Bind off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
