# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Alpine Wool Barbizon Lace Scarf Pattern Number: 90648AD

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

**SIZE:** One Size About 10 x 140 in. (25.5 x 355.5 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- 822-099 <u>Lion Brand Alpine Wool: Vanilla</u> 10 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 8 [5 mm]
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

#### GAUGE:

14 sts + 20 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) over Arrow Lace. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

sk2p Slip 1 as if to knit, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over - 2 sts decreased.
ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together - 1 st decreased.

PATTERN STITCHES
Arrow Lace (multiple of 10 sts + 1)
Row 1 (WS): Purl.
Row 2: K1, \*(yo, ssk) twice, k1, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1; rep from \* across.
Row 3: Purl.
Row 4: K2, yo, ssk, yo, sl 2 sts as if to knit, k1, pass 2 slipped sts over, yo, k2tog, yo, \*k3, yo, ssk, yo, sl 2 sts as if to knit, k1, pass 2 slipped sts over, yo; rep from \* across to last 2 sts, k2.
Rep Rows 1-4 for Arrow Lace.

Rib Lace (multiple of 10 sts + 1) Row 1 (WS): Purl. Row 2: K1, \*yo, k3, sk2p, k3, yo, k1; rep from \* across. Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Rib Lace.

Mesh Lace (multiple of 6 sts + 1) Row 1 (WS): Purl. Row 2: K1, \*yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from \* across. Row 3: Purl.
Row 4: K1, \*yo, k1, sk2p, k1, yo, k1; rep from \* across.
Row 5: Purl.
Row 6: K1, \*k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1; rep from \* across.
Row 7: Purl.
Row 8: K2tog, \*(k1, yo) twice, k1, sk2p; rep from \* across to last 5 sts, (k1, yo) twice, k1, ssk.
Rep Rows 1-8 for Mesh Lace.

# Horseshoe Lace (multiple of 10 sts + 1)

Row 1 (WS): Purl.
Row 2: K1, \*yo, k3, sk2p, k3, yo, k1; rep from \* across
Row 3: Purl.
Row 4: P1, \*k1, yo, k2, sk2p, k2, yo, k1, p1; rep from \* across.
Row 5: K1, \*p9, k1; rep from \* across.
Row 6: P1, \*k2, yo, k1, sk2p, k1, yo, k2, p1; rep from \* across.
Row 7: Rep Row 5.
Row 8: P1, \*k3, yo, sk2p, yo, k3, p1; rep from \* across.
Rep Rows 1-8 for Horseshoe Lace.

# Seed Stitch (over even number of sts)

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* across. **Row 2:** K the purl sts, p the knit sts. Rep Row 2 for Seed Stitch.

# NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in 4 different lace patterns, always keeping the first and last 2 sts of every row in Seed st.

2. Each lace pattern is worked for 10 in. (25.5 cm).

3. If you'd like to make a shorter scarf, simply work fewer lace sections.

To adjust yarn amount for a shorter scarf, note that each ball of yarn will make about 1 1/2 lace sections.

4. When working first row of each lace pattern, place a st marker between each rep of lace pattern, for ease in counting your sts.

#### SCARF

Cast on 35 sts.

# \*Arrow Lace section of Scarf

Row 1 (WS): K1, p1, work Row 1 of Arrow Lace over next 31 sts, p1, k1.

Keeping first and last 2 sts in Seed st, and rem sts in Arrow Lace, rep Rows 1-4 of Arrow Lace for about 10 in. (25.5 cm); end with a RS row.

#### **Rib Lace section of Scarf**

**Next Row (WS):** Work in Seed st over first 2 sts, work Row 1 of Rib Lace over next 31 sts, work in Seed st over last 2 sts.

Keeping first and last 2 sts in Seed st, and rem sts in Rib Lace, rep Rows 1 and 2 of Rib Lace for about 10 in. (25.5 cm); end with a RS row.

#### Mesh Lace section of Scarf

**Next Row (WS):** Work in Seed st over first 2 sts, work Row 1 of Mesh Lace over next 31 sts, work in Seed st over last 2 sts.

Keeping first and last 2 sts in Seed st, and rem sts in Mesh Lace, rep Rows 1-8 of Mesh Lace for about 10 in. (25.5 cm); end with a RS row.

#### **Horseshoe Lace section of Scarf**

**Next Row (WS):** Work in Seed st over first 2 sts, work Row 1 of Horseshoe Lace over next 31 sts, work in Seed st over last 2 sts.

Keeping first and last 2 sts in Seed st, and rem sts in Horseshoe Lace, rep Rows 1-8 of Horseshoe Lace for about 10 in. (25.5 cm); end with a RS row.

Rep from \* 2 more times, thus working each lace section 2 more times.

# Last 2 sections of Scarf

**Next Row (WS):** Work in Seed st over first 2 sts, work Row 1 of Arrow Lace over next 31 sts, work in Seed st over last 2 sts.

Keeping first and last 2 sts in Seed st, and rem sts in Arrow Lace, rep Rows 1-4 of Arrow Lace for about 10 in. (25.5 cm); end with a RS row.

**Next Row (WS):** Work in Seed st over first 2 sts, work Row 1 of Rib Lace over next 31 sts, work in Seed st over last 2 sts.

Keeping first and last 2 sts in Seed st, and rem sts in Rib Lace, rep Rows 1 and 2 of Rib Lace for about 10 in. (25.5 cm); end with a RS row. Bind off.

# bind off.

# FINISHING

Weave in ends.
