### **MATERIALS**

• 830-100 Lion Brand New Cotton-Ease: Snow

6 Balls

- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles
- Boye Aluminum Circular Knitting Needles 29 inches Size 10

# **GAUGE:**

15 sts + 19 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern st, with 2 strands of yarn held tog. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

# Seed Stitch (over an even number of sts)

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* across. **Row 2:** P the knit sts, and k the purl sts. Rep Rows 2 for Seed st.

# NOTES:

- 1. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 2. Blankie is worked with 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

## **BLANKIE**

With 2 strands of yarn held tog, cast on 108 sts.

Working back and forth in rows, as if working on straight needles, work in Seed st for 8 rows.

**Next 10 Rows:** Work in Seed st over first 6 sts, \*k8, p8; rep from \* to last 6 sts, work in Seed st over last 6 sts.

**Next 10 Rows:** Work in Seed st over first 6 sts, \*p8, k8; rep from \* to last 6 sts, work in Seed st over last 6 sts.

Rep last 20 rows 6 more times.

Work in Seed st for 8 rows.

Bind off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
